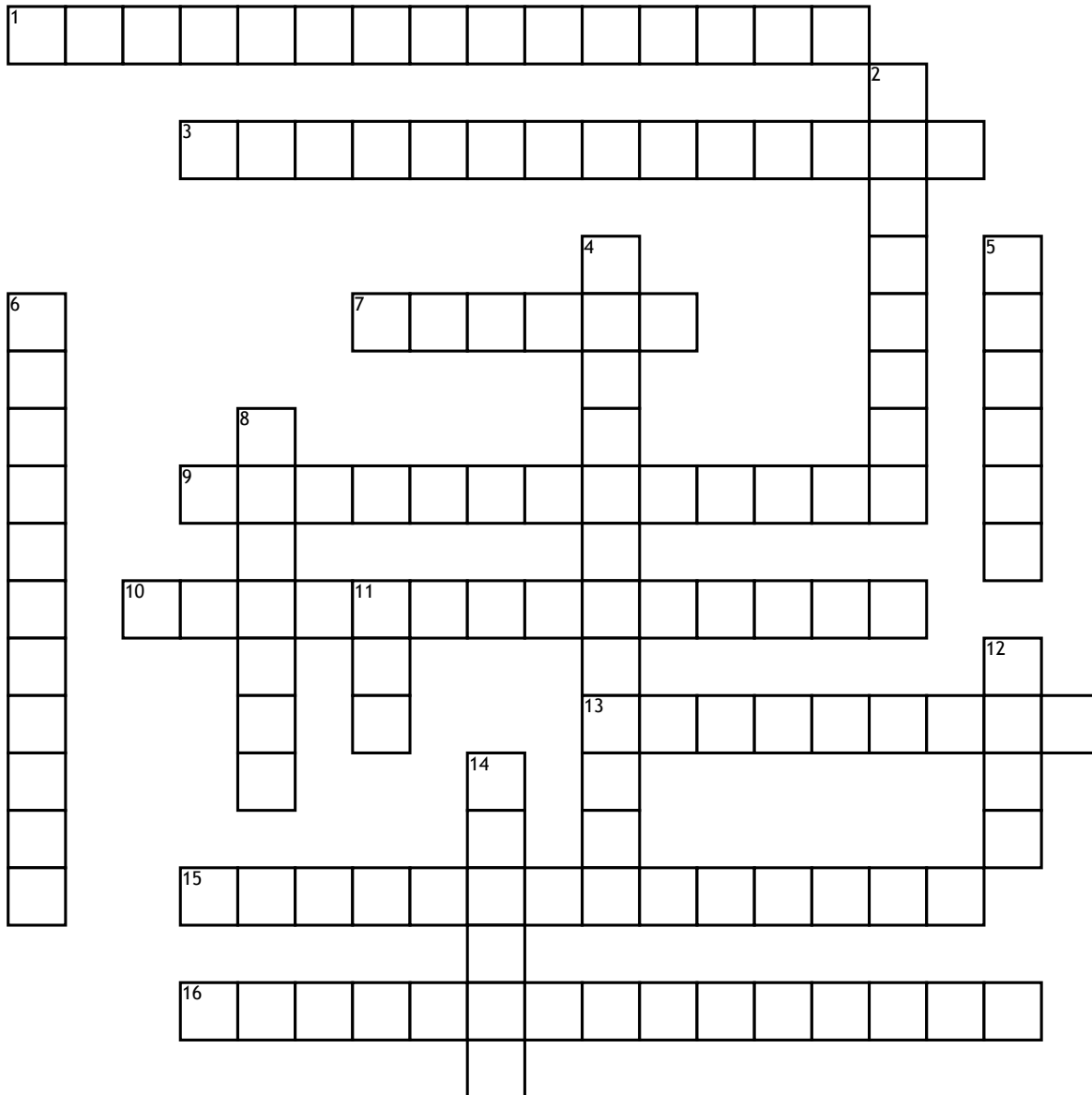


# Replantation
