
Reproductive System

- 2. Male sex cells
- **6.** Male hormone needed for reproductive organ function
- **9.** Egg/female sex cell
- 10. Lets ovum travel to the uterus
- **13.** Sac holding testes between the thighs
- **16.** Neck/narrow section of the uterus
- 17. Main part of the uterus
- **19.** Male sex glands that produce sperm and testosterone
- **21.** Lining of the uterus breaks up and is discharged through the uterus

- **23.** A fluid that carries sperm from the male reproductive tract
- **25.** Stores sperm and produce semen **Down**
- 1. Outlet for urine and semen
- **3.** Donut shaped gland that secretes fluid into the semen
- **4.** Organ system allowing human reproduction
- **5.** Hollow, muscular organ shaped like a pear
- 7. Tissue lining the uterus
- **8.** When sperm and ovum unite and become one cell

- 11. A coiled tube on the top and side of the testes that the sperm travel through
- 12. Muscular canal
- 14. Release of an ovum
- 15. Unborn baby
- **18.** Female sex glands that produce ovum, estrogen and progesterone
- **20.** Female hormone needed for reproductive system function
- 22. Sex glands
- **24.** A fold of skin at the end of the penis
