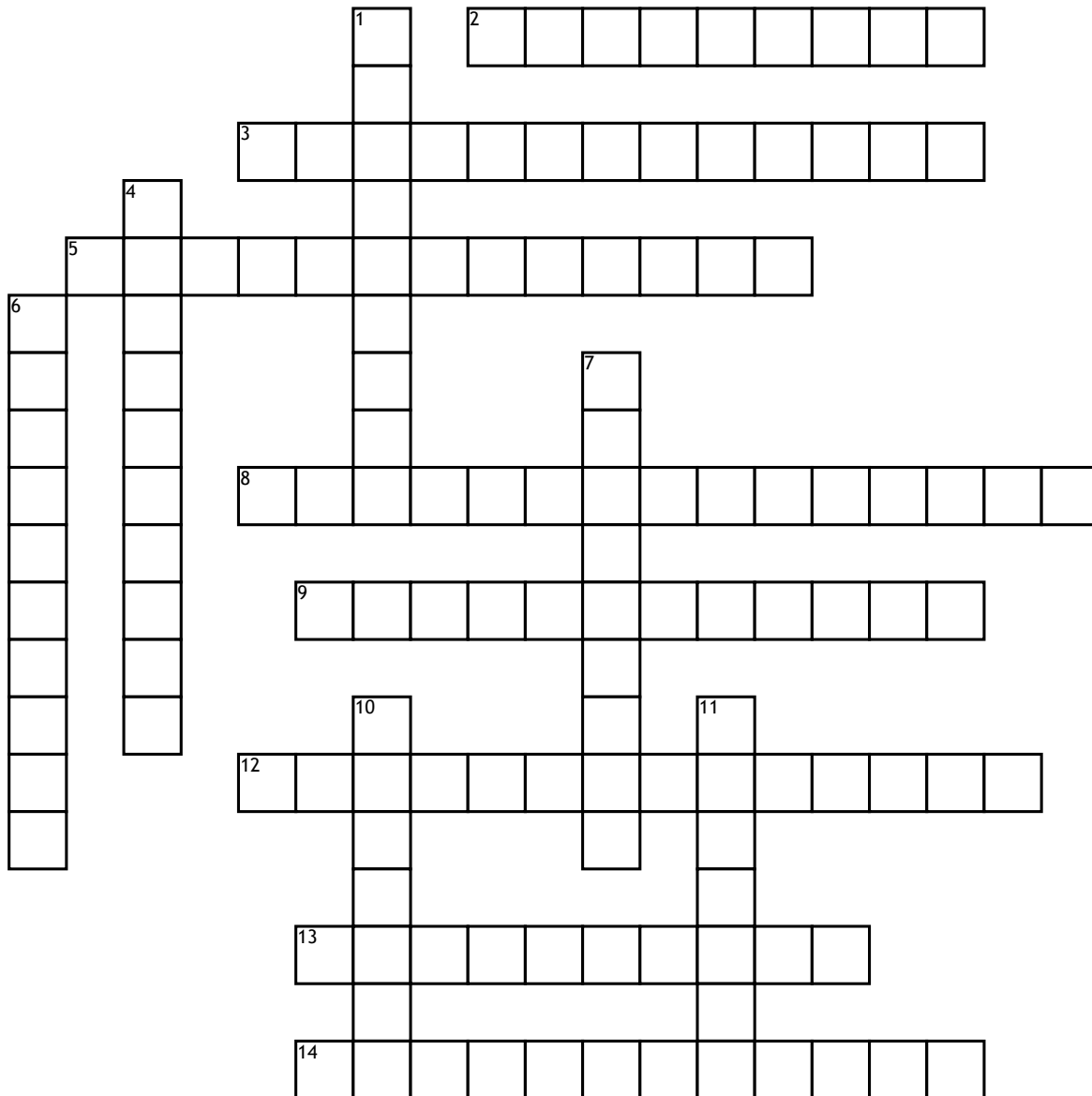

8. a condition where menstruation occurs but is not visible due to an obstruction of the outflow tract.
