

- 1. A bag of skin where the testes are contained

- 6. Carries urine or semen lout of the body. This swells with blood and stiffens, this is known as an erection. Allows the male to release sperm into a female during sexual intercourse
- **9.** A tube that carries urine from the bladder out of the body or sperm from sperm duct
- **13.** A neck of tissue that connects the vagina and uterus
