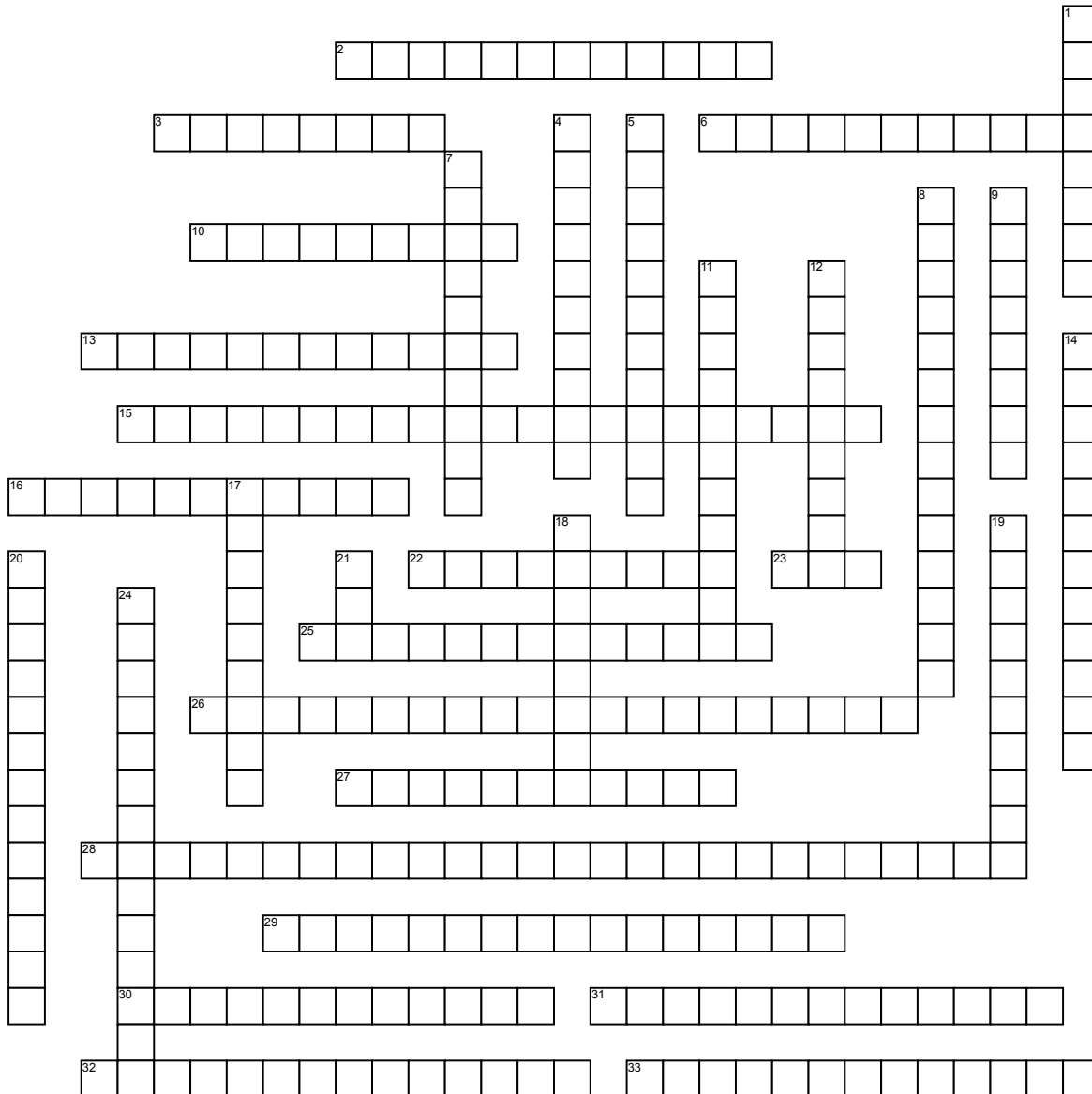


Reproductive system

2. a surgical operation to remove all or part of the uterus
 3. a chronic bacterial disease that is contracted chiefly by infection during sexual intercourse, but also congenitally by infection of a developing fetus
 6. inflammation of the prostate gland
 10. an infection you can get by having sex
 13. Painful menstruation typically involving an abdominal cramps
 15. The injection of semen into the vagina or uterus other than by sexual intercourse
 16. inability to conceive children or young
 22. a venereal disease involving inflammatory discharge from the urethra or vagina.
 23. refers to physical and emotional symptoms that occur in the one to two weeks before a woman's period
 25. a disease characterized by blisters in the genital area, caused by a variety of the herpes simplex virus.
 26. a medical procedure whereby an egg is fertilized by sperm in a test tube or elsewhere outside the body
 27. a surgical procedure in which a fiber-optic instrument is inserted through the abdominal wall to view the organs in the abdomen or to permit a surgical procedure
 28. Enlargement of the prostate gland caused by a benign overgrowth of chiefly glandular tissue
 29. A pregnancy in which the fetus develops outside the uterus typically in a fallopian tube

30. The action of practice of circumcising a young boy or man
 31. A condition resulting from the appearance of endometrial tissue outside the uterus and causing pelvic pain
 32. A condition in which one or both of the testes fail to descend from the abdomen into the scrotum
 33. a surgical operation to remove all or part of the prostate gland

1. a test carried out on a sample of cells from the cervix to check for abnormalities that may be indicative of cervical cancer
 4. An abnormal absence of menstruation
 5. inability to conceive children or young
 7. the moment in pregnancy when the pregnant woman starts to feel or perceive fetal movements in the uterus
 8. A type of cancer that occurs in the cells of the cervix
 9. inflammation of the mammary gland in the breast or udder, typically due to bacterial infection via a damaged nipple or teat
 11. the expulsion of a fetus from the womb before it is able to survive independently, especially spontaneously or as the result of accident
 12. an image obtained by mammography
 14. Starts when cells in the breast begin to grow out of control
 17. inability to take effective action; helplessness

18. inflammation of one or both of the testicles
 19. a surgical operation to remove a breast
 20. The deliberate use of artificial methods or other techniques to prevent pregnancy as a consequence of sexual intercourse
 21. Bovine spongiform encephalopathy a usually fatal disease of cattle affecting the central nervous system, causing agitation and staggering
 24. cancer that occurs in the prostate — a small walnut-shaped gland in men that produces the seminal fluid that nourishes and transports sperm.
