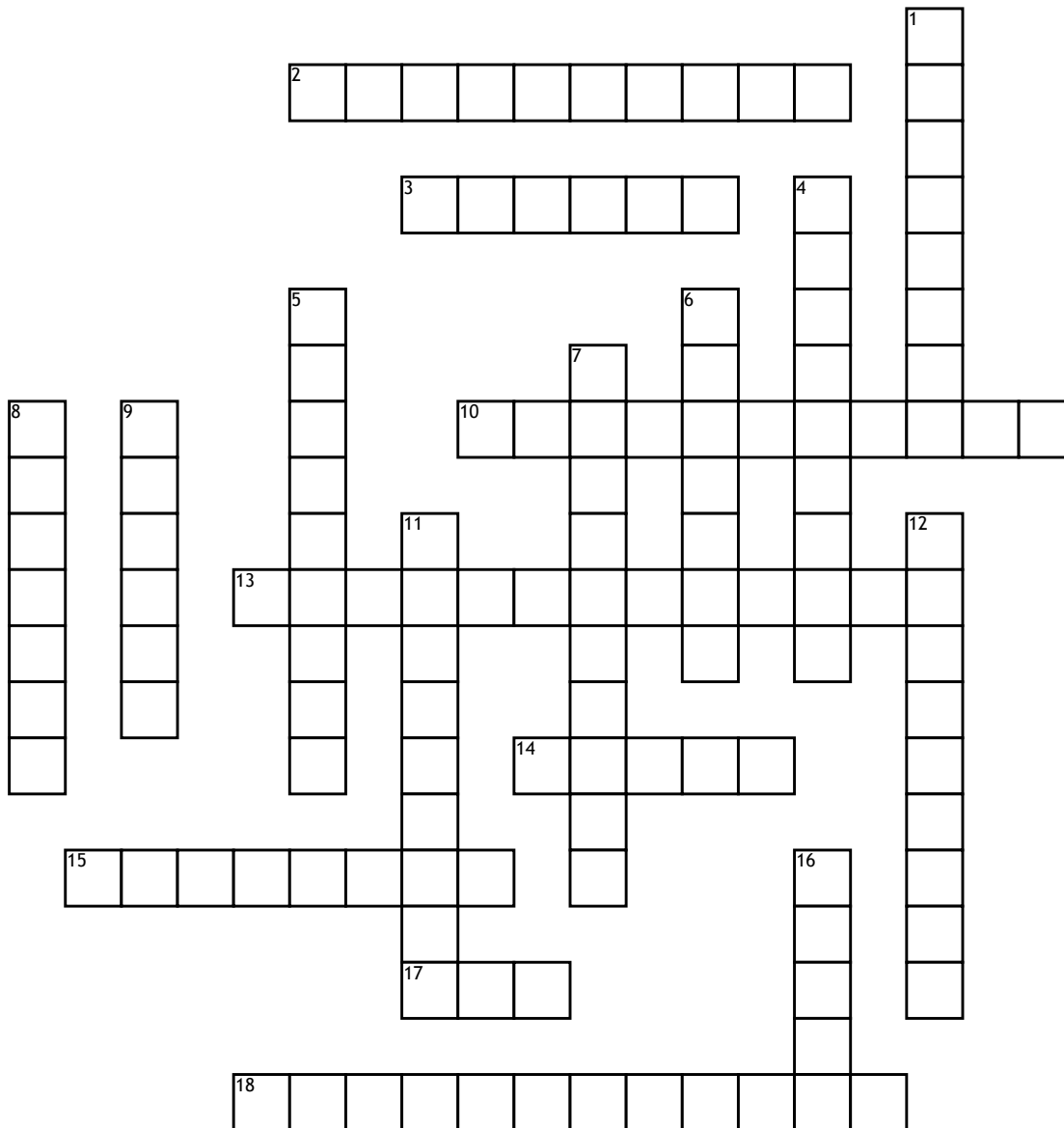

## Across

2. Placement of endotracheal tube  
 3. Administered for decreased SpO<sub>2</sub>  
 10. Collapse of alveoli  
 13. Steroid given prior to extubation  
 14. Symptoms include barking cough, steeple sign  
 15. Deformity of nail beds often seen with chronic respiratory disease

17. Blood test used to check PH, PCO<sub>2</sub>, PO<sub>2</sub> and HCO<sub>3</sub>  
 18. Collection of air in pleural space

## Down

1. Bluish skin, nail beds and mucous membranes  
 4. Bronchodilator often used in asthma  
 5. Decrease in oxygen level in blood  
 6. Space between lung and chest cavity

7. Collection of blood in pleural space

8. Type of epinephrine often nebulized

9. Leaning forward position to improve respiratory distress

11. Rapid breathing

12. Symptoms include, coughing fits and apnea

16. Absence of breathing
