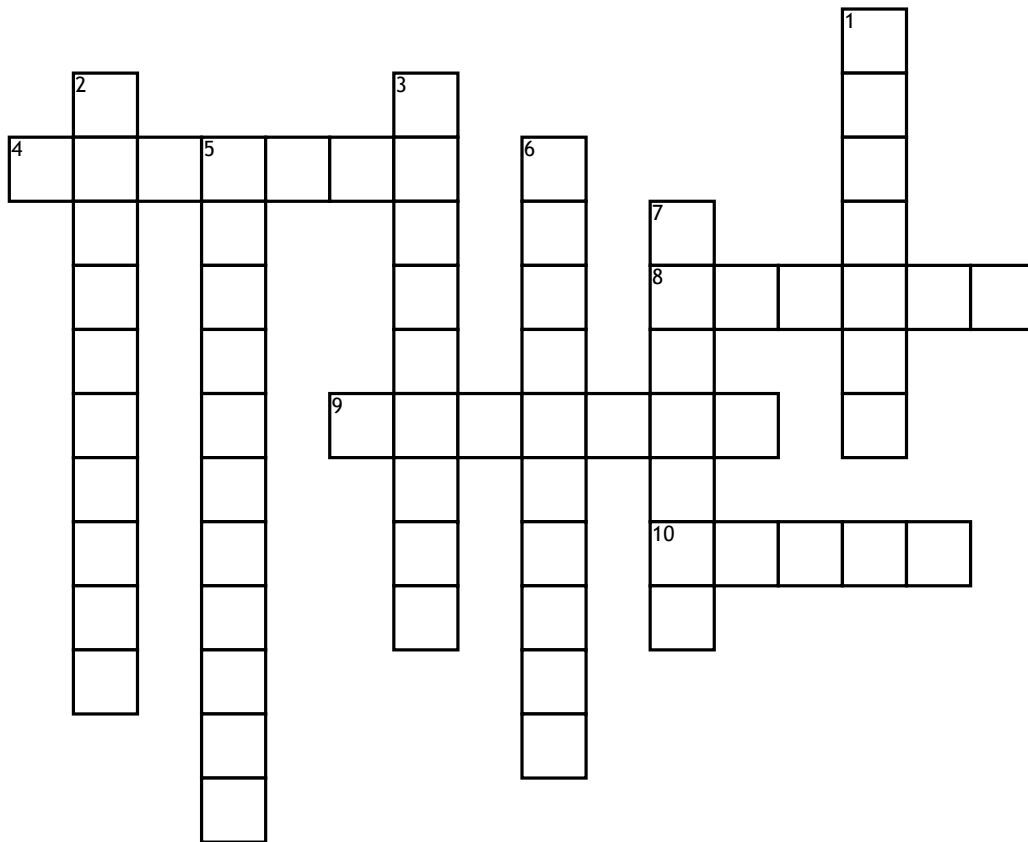

 8. Contains the vocal cords, also called the voice box.
 9. The pipe that directs air into the chest, also called the wind pipe.
 10. spongy tissue that expands and contracts as we breath.

1. Where the nasal cavity and oral cavity join.
 2. air can enter but is not filtered
 3. Flat muscle at the bottom of the lungs that expands the rib cage.
 5. Where air is filtered, warmed and moistened before entering the lungs
 6. The air tubes that reduce in size as they take air into the lungs.
 7. Air sacks at the end of the bronchiole where gas exchange occurs.
