

- **4.** Two tubes that split off the bottom of the trachea.
- **8.** Contains the vocal cords, also called the voice box.
- **9.** The pipe that directs air into the chest, also called the wind pipe.
- **10.** spongy tissue that expands and contracts as we breath.

<u>Down</u>

- 1. Where the nasal cavity and oral cavity join.
- 2. air can enter but is not filtered
- **3.** Flat muscle at the bottom of the lungs that expands the rib cage.
- **5.** Where air is filtered, warmed and moistened before entering the lungs
- **6.** The air tubes that reduce in size as they take air into the lungs.
- **7.** Air sacks at the end of the bronchiole where gas exchange occurs.
