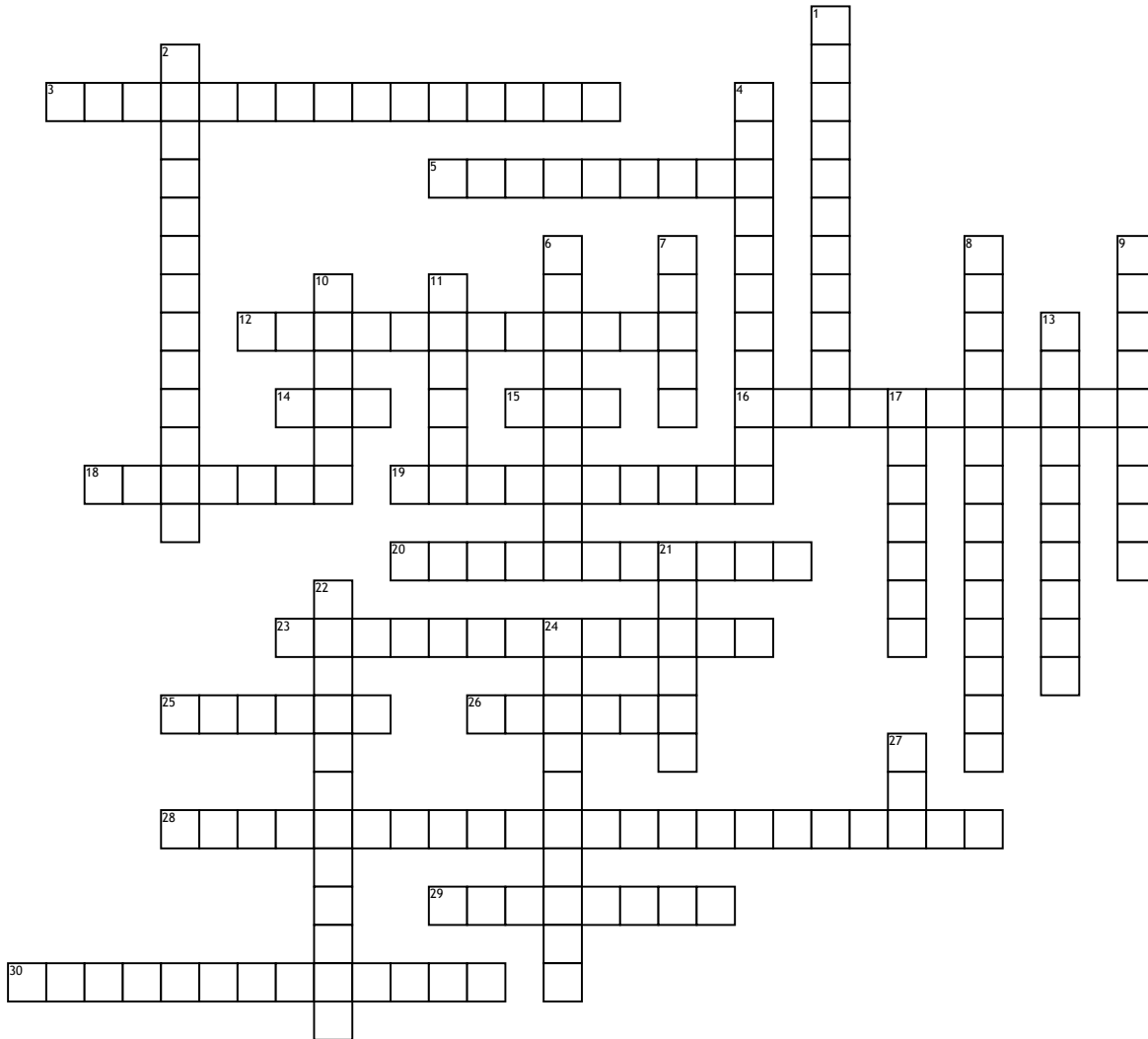


Respiratory System
