

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Respiratory System



Across

- **6.** dome-shaped muscle that separates the thoracic and abdominal cavities
- 7. Tubes that carry air closer to the sight of external respiration
- **8.** Tiny blood vessel through which gas exchange takes place
- **9.** Carries oxygenated blood to the heart

- **10.** Tiny air sac through which the gas exchange of external respiration takes place
- 11. Voice box, contains the vocal cords
- **12.** Oxygen moves from the lungs into the blood, the carbon dioxide moves from the blood into the lungs

Down

- **1.** Oxygen moves from the blood into the cells, and carbon dioxide moves from the cells into the blood
- **2.** Brings blood from the heart into the lungs
- **3.** Passages through which air spreads through the lungs
- 4. Windpipe
- **5.** Flap of tissue that closes over the trachea when you swallow
