

- **2.** A flap of cartilaginous tissue that covers the opening to the trachea
- 3. The bony front part of the palate
- **7.** Gas-exchange structure that contains the alveoli and the capillaries surrounding the alveoli
- **13.** A substance which tends to reduce the surface tension of a liquid in which it is dissolved
- **16.** The thin, double-walled serous membrane that surrounds the lungs
- 17. A spiral or or circular course around a circuit
- **18.** Air sacs in the lungs from which gas is exchanged with the capillaries
- ${\bf 19.}$ Each of the pair of organs situated within the rib cage
- **20.** The part of the larynx consisting of the vocal cords and the opening between them

- 23. The fleshy, flexible part toward the back of the roof of the mouth
- **24.** The part of the alimentary canal that connects the throat to the stomach
- **25.** Three uneven, scroll-like nasal bones that extend down through the nasal cavity

- 1. The thin-walled branches of the bronchi
- **4.** The muscular passageway that extends from the nasal cavity to the mouth and connects to the esophagus
- 5. The two passageways that branch off the trachea and lead to the right and left lungs
- **6.** The area of the thoracic cavity between the lungs
- **8.** A triangular-shaped space inferior to the pharynx that is responsible for voice production

- **9.** A thin tubular structure that arises from respiratory bronchioles and gives rise to alveoli
- **10.** This is divided into a vestibule and the oral cavity proper
- **11.** The two openings in the nose through which air enters
- **12.** Small openings in the alveolar walls that allow gases and macrophages to travel between the alveoli
- 14. The largest cartilaginous plate in the larynx
- **15.** The inside part of your nose that is lined with a mucous membrane
- **21.** The air tube that extends from the larynx into the thorax, where it splits into the right and left bronchi
- 22. The air-filled cavities that surround the nose
