
Respiratory System Disorders



<u>Across</u>

6. Bluish colouring of the skin and mucus membranes
7. Reduces surface tension and prevents collapse of alveoli.

9. Cellular components that accumulate in the exudate and forms a solid mass

10. Upper respiratory tract infection with sudden onset of fever, marked with fatigue and body pain.

12. Inadequate oxygen in blood

13. Inadequate oxygen in the cells

<u>Down</u>

1. Cessation of breathing

2. Part of nasal passages that warms and moistens the air.

3. Hospital acquired pneumonia

4. Entry point of bronchus and blood vessels into the lungs

5. Disease where lymphopenia and thrombocytopenia are often present
