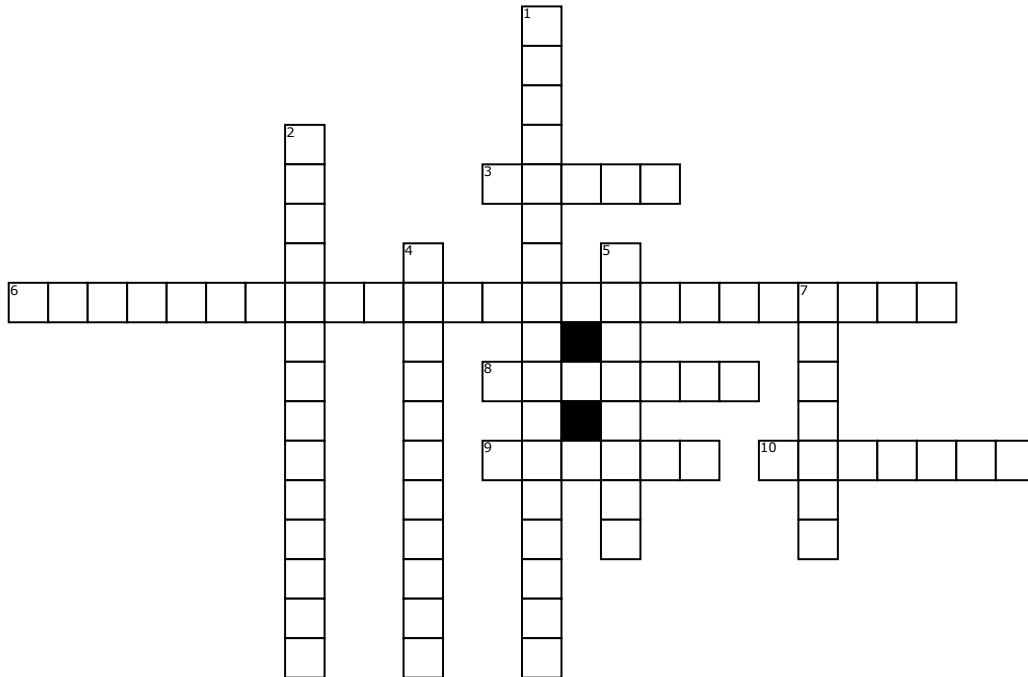

9. is a condition in which your airways narrow and swell and may produce extra mucus.
10. cone-shaped tube which connects the nasal passages to the larynx (and esophagus); commonly known as the throat

- 1.** body system responsible for processing oxygen and carbon dioxide through breathing (respiration)
2. hollow cavity lined with mucous membrane and located in the skull around the nasal cavity
4. chamber extending from the nares (nostrils) to the pharynx
5. is a passage or airway in the respiratory system that conducts air into the lungs.
7. tube which extends from the larynx toward the lungs
