
## Respiratory System



## <u>Across</u>

- **3.** microscopic hair-like structures (singular: cilium)
- **6.** bony projections which increase the surface area of the nasal cavity
- 8. passageways from the trachea to the lungs (singular: bronchus)
- **9.** is a condition in which your airways narrow and swell and may produce extra mucus.
- **10.** cone-shaped tube which connects the nasal passages to the larynx (and esophagus); 7. tube which extends from the larynx commonly known as the throat

- **1.** body system responsible for processing oxygen and carbon dioxide through breathing (respiration)
- 2. hollow cavity lined with mucous membrane and located in the skull around the nasal cavity
- 4. chamber extending from the nares (nostrils) to the pharynx
- **5.** is a passage or airway in the respiratory system that conducts air into the lungs.
- toward the lungs
