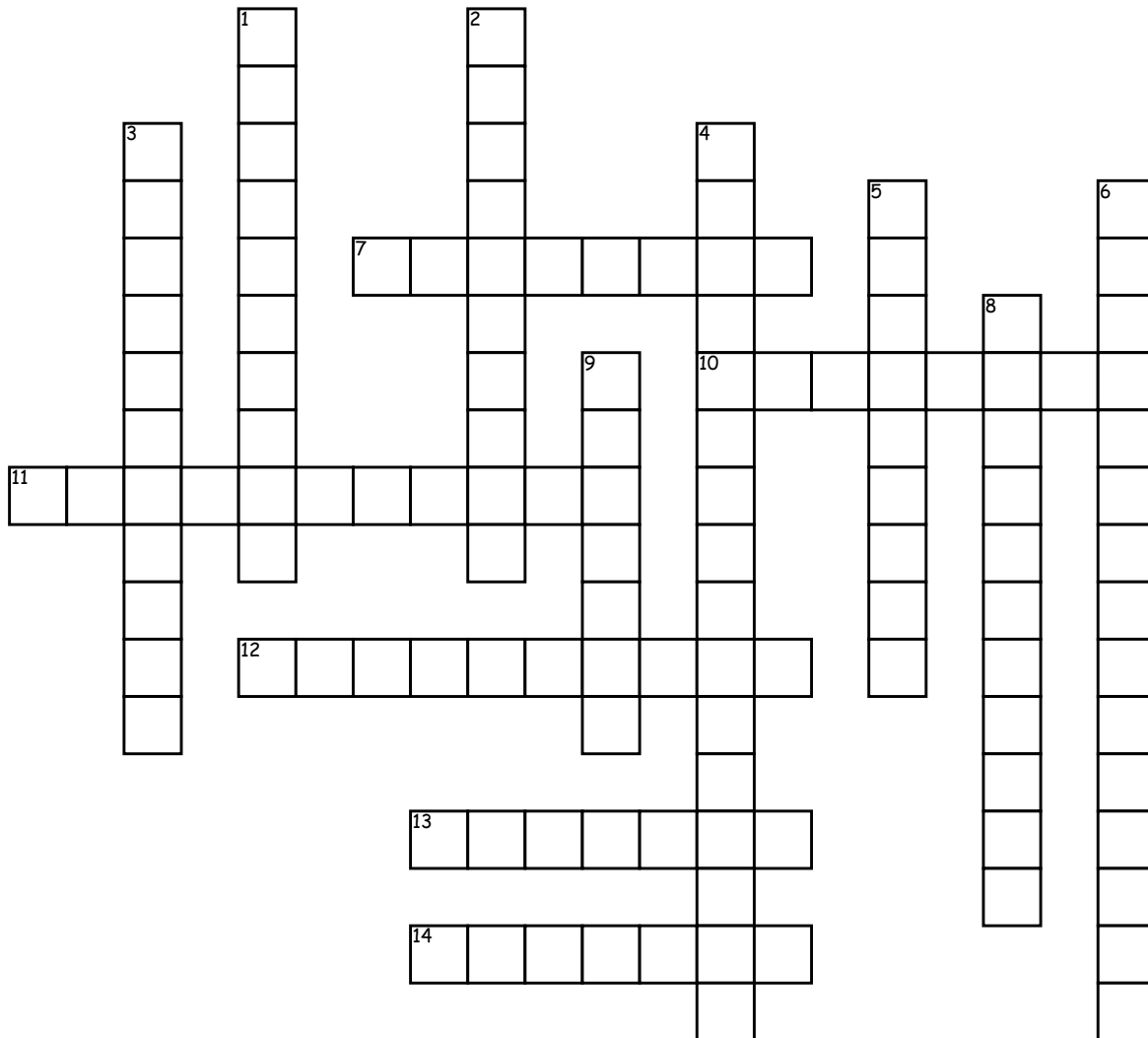

13. a large membranous tube reinforced by rings of cartilage, extending from the larynx to the bronchial tubes and conveying air to and from the lungs;

2. nasal tone in speech especially when caused by excessive closure
