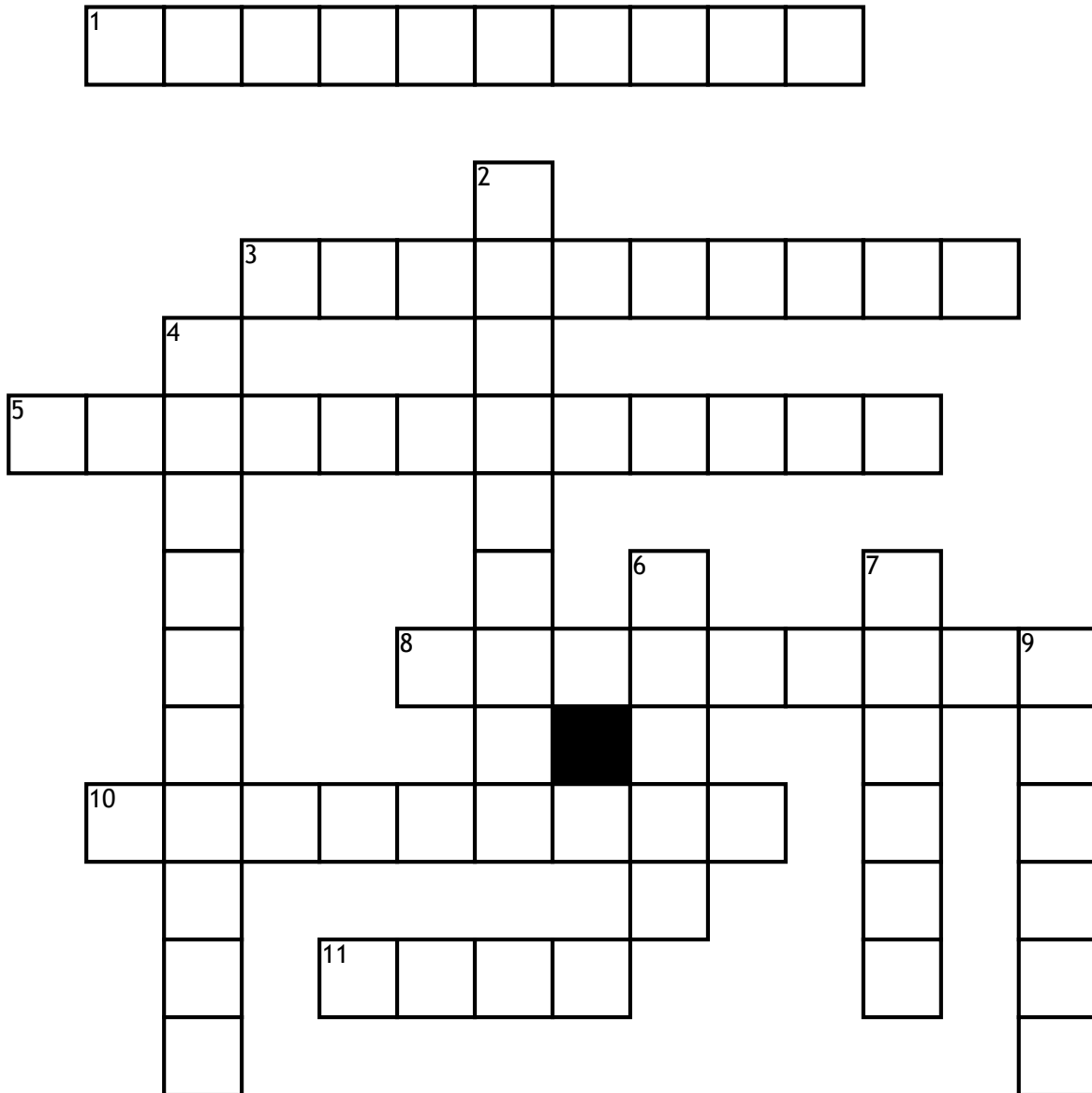


Review 1.01 Typography

- 1. Designed strictly to catch the eye/used for decoration (Ex. Bauhaus)
- 3. Appearance of text
- 5. Amount of horizontal space each character takes up varies
- 8. Basic design of a character
- 10. No strokes at the tips of the letters
- 11. Specific size, weight, and style applied to a typeface.

- 2. Bold, italic and stroke are examples. This refer to the slant, weight and special effects applied to the text,
- 4. Courier is _____. Each character takes up the same amount of horizontal space.
- 6. Strokes at the tips of the letters
- 7. Appear to have been written by hand (Convey a formal mood).
