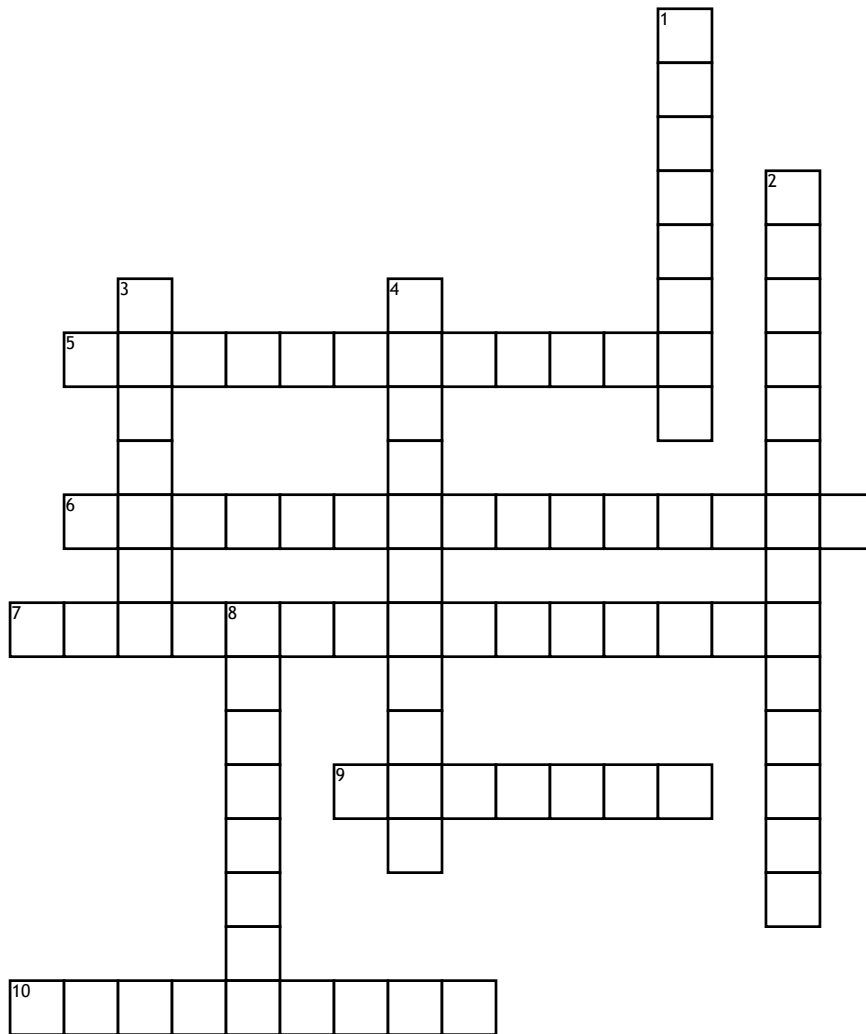


Revolution Crossword

- 5. was a series of measures, passed by the British Parliament in 1767

- 7. were punitive laws passed by the British Parliament in 1774 after the Boston Tea Party.

- 10. were civilian colonists who independently organized to form militia companies self-trained in weaponry, tactics, and military strategies from the American colonial partisan militia during the American Revolutionary War.

- 1. also known as Revolutionaries, Continentals, Rebels, or American Whigs)
- 2. in 1768 to enforce unpopular taxation measures passed by a British parliament that lacked American representation.
- 3. to engage in a concerted refusal to have dealings with (a person, a store, an organization, etc.)
- 4. hired professional soldier who fights for any state or nation without regard to political interests or issues.
- 8. also called Tory, colonist loyal to Great Britain during the American Revolution.
