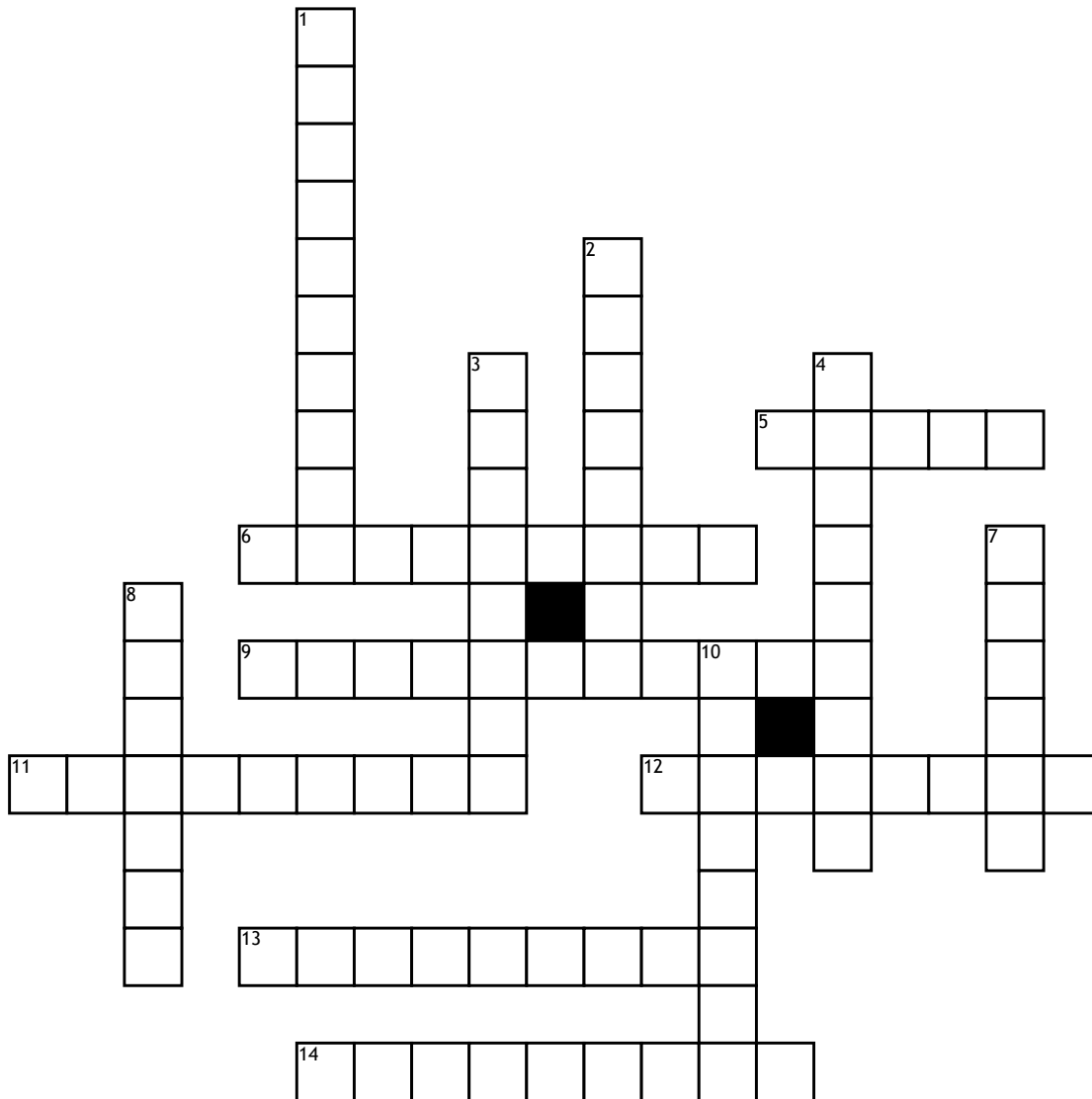


Revolution Crossword
