
Revolutionary War Crossword Puzzle (1)

- 2. Where groups of people that communicated with other towns come to share news and ideas about new British Laws and how to change them.
- **6.** Passed in 1764, it changed the duties on molasses and sugar.
- **9.** Secret society that protested against the Stamp Act, sometimes they used violence.
- **10.** Colonists who chose to side with Great Britain.

- 11. On December 16, 1773, angry colonists dressed as Native Americans and sneaked onto ships owned by the British Indian Tea Company and dumped barrels of tea into the harbor.
- **12.** Colonists rented to British soldiers in their own town; a fight broke out in town and the British soldiers fired into the crowd and killed three men.
