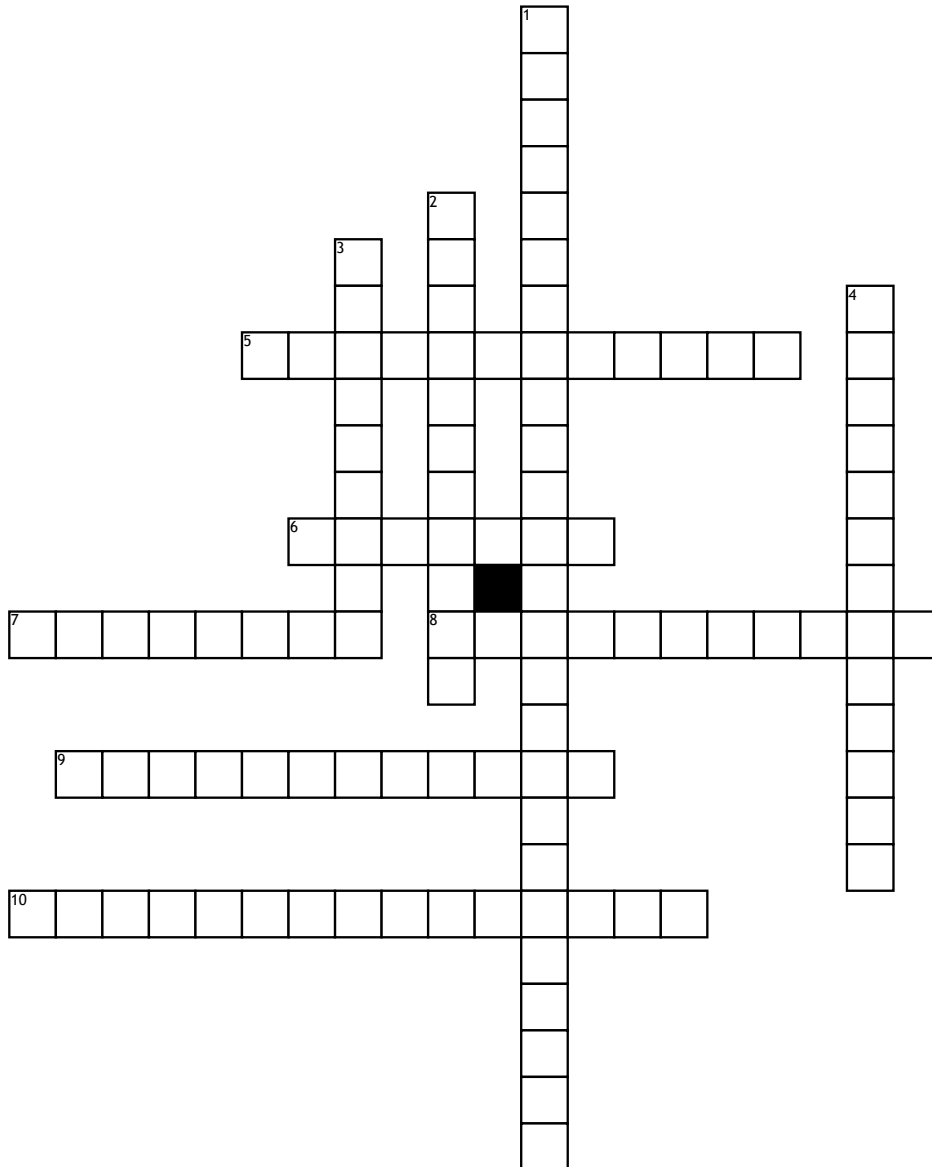


Revolutionary war
