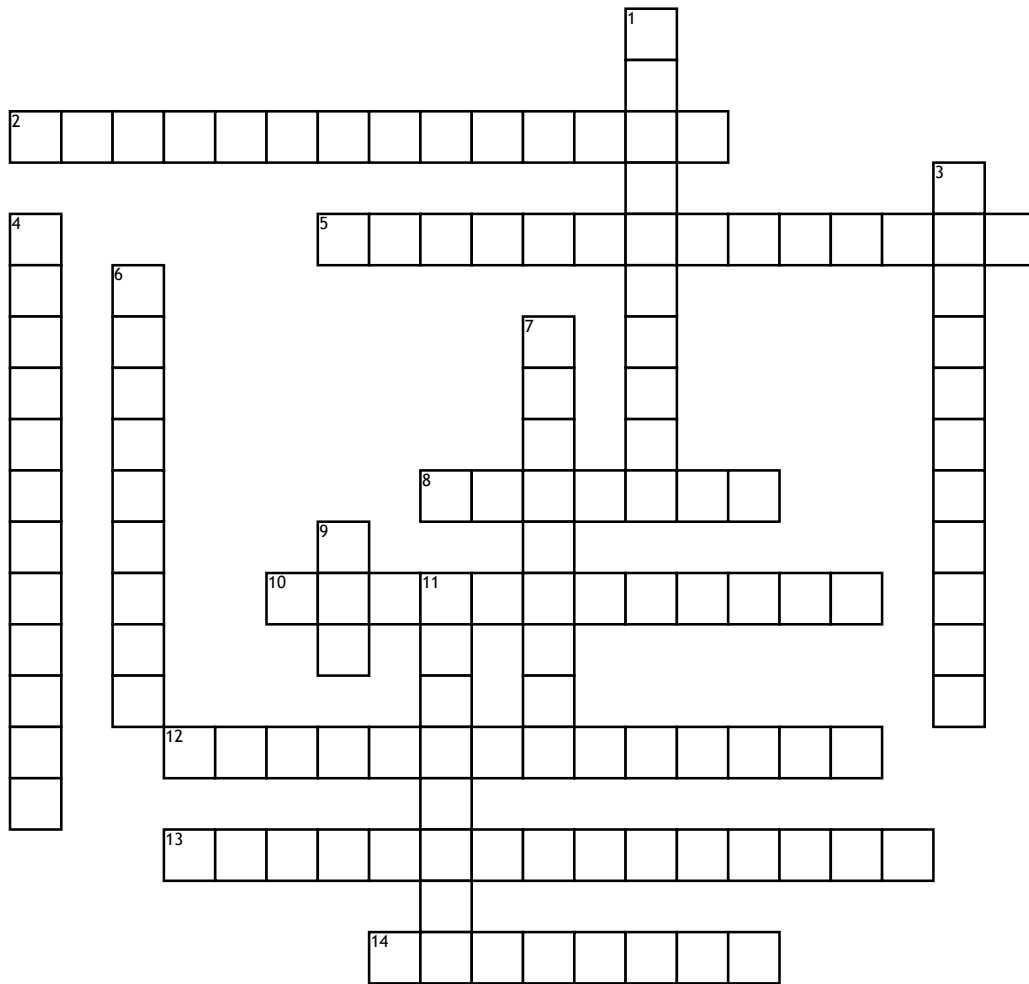


Rock the Vote Crossword Puzzle

- 2. a ballot used used for an absentee vote
- 5. the dividing of a state, county, etc., into election districts so as to give one political party a majority in many districts while concentrating the voting strength of the other party into as few districts as possible
- 8. the process by which voters, either the general public (open primary) or members of a political party (closed primary), can indicate their preference for a candidate in an upcoming general election or by-election, thus narrowing the field of candidates

- 10. a body of constituents; the voters or residents in a district represented by an elective officer
- 12. The two-round system is a voting method used to elect a single winner, where the voter casts a single vote for their chosen candidate
- 13. a regularly scheduled local, state, or national election in which voters elect officeholders
- 14. a book in which records of acts, events, names, etc., are kept
