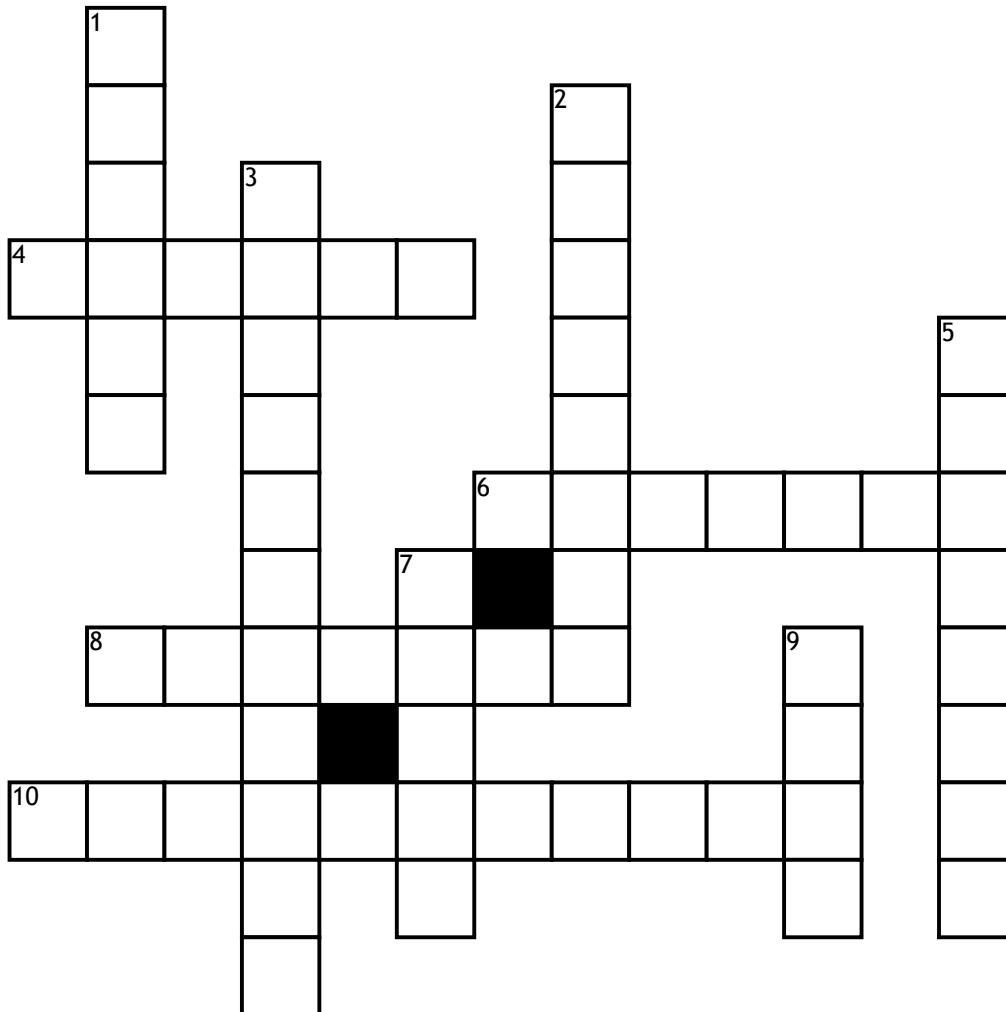


Rocks and Minerals
