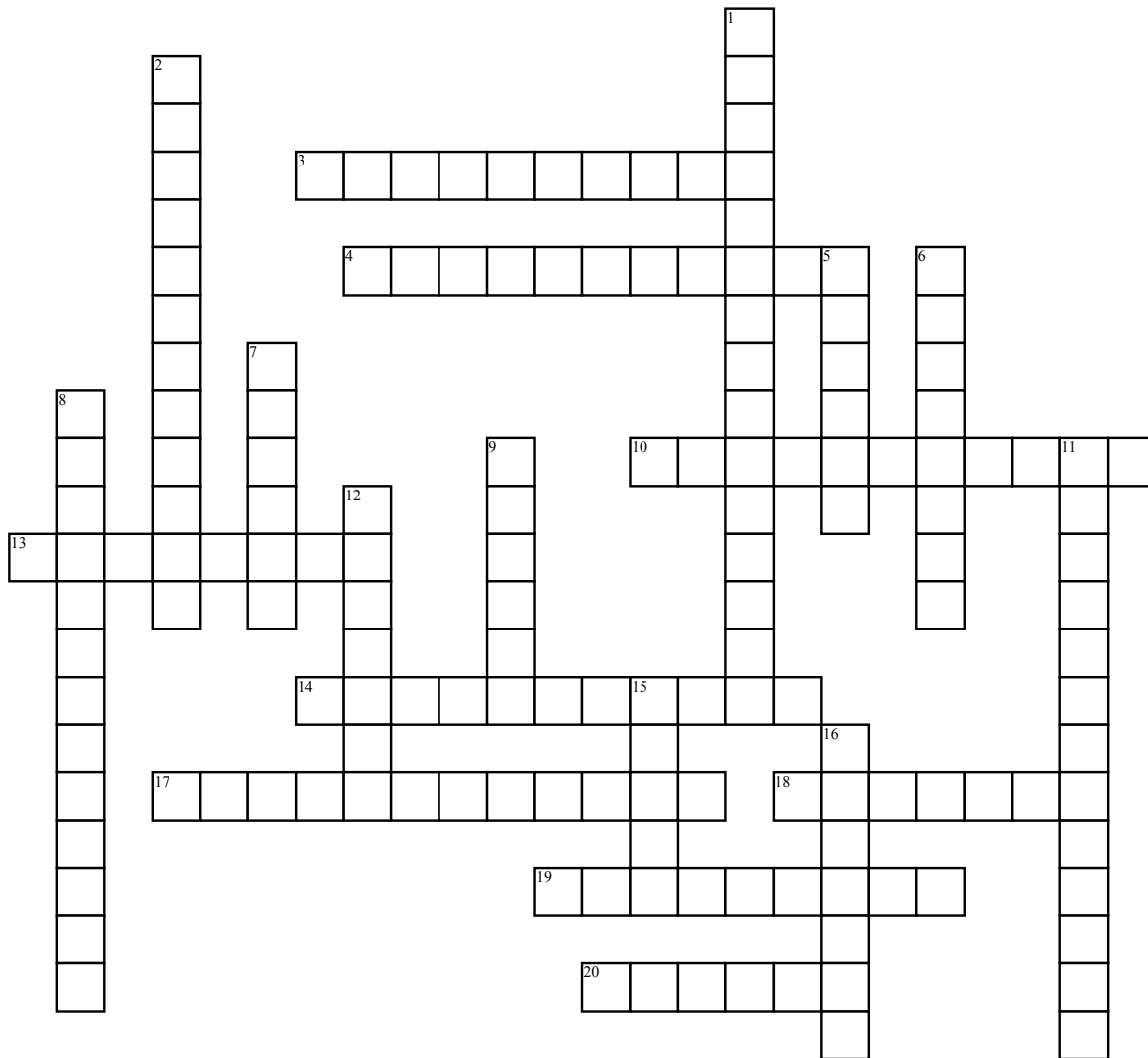


Roll Call Crossword
