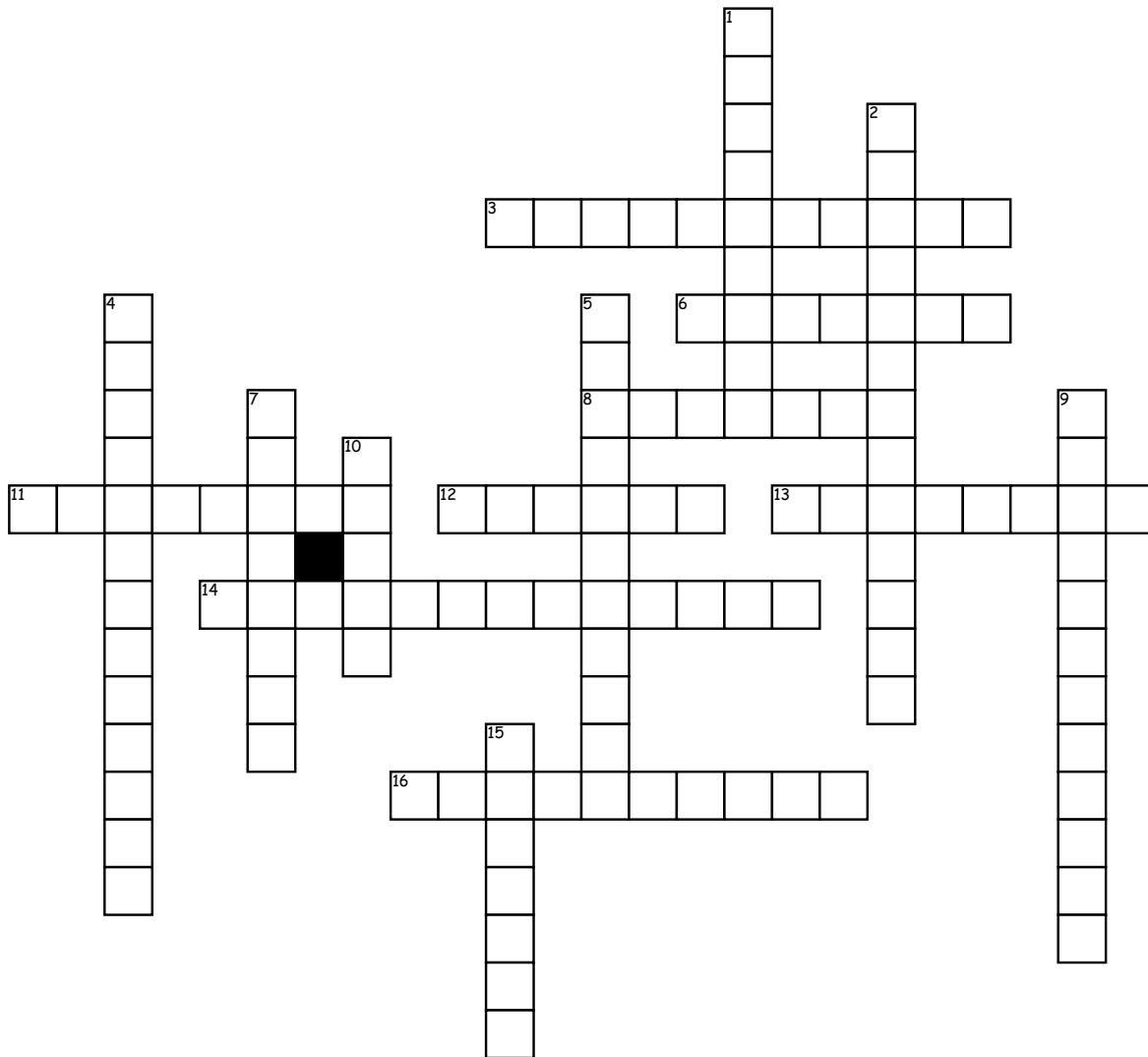


Roll of Thunder Puzzle
