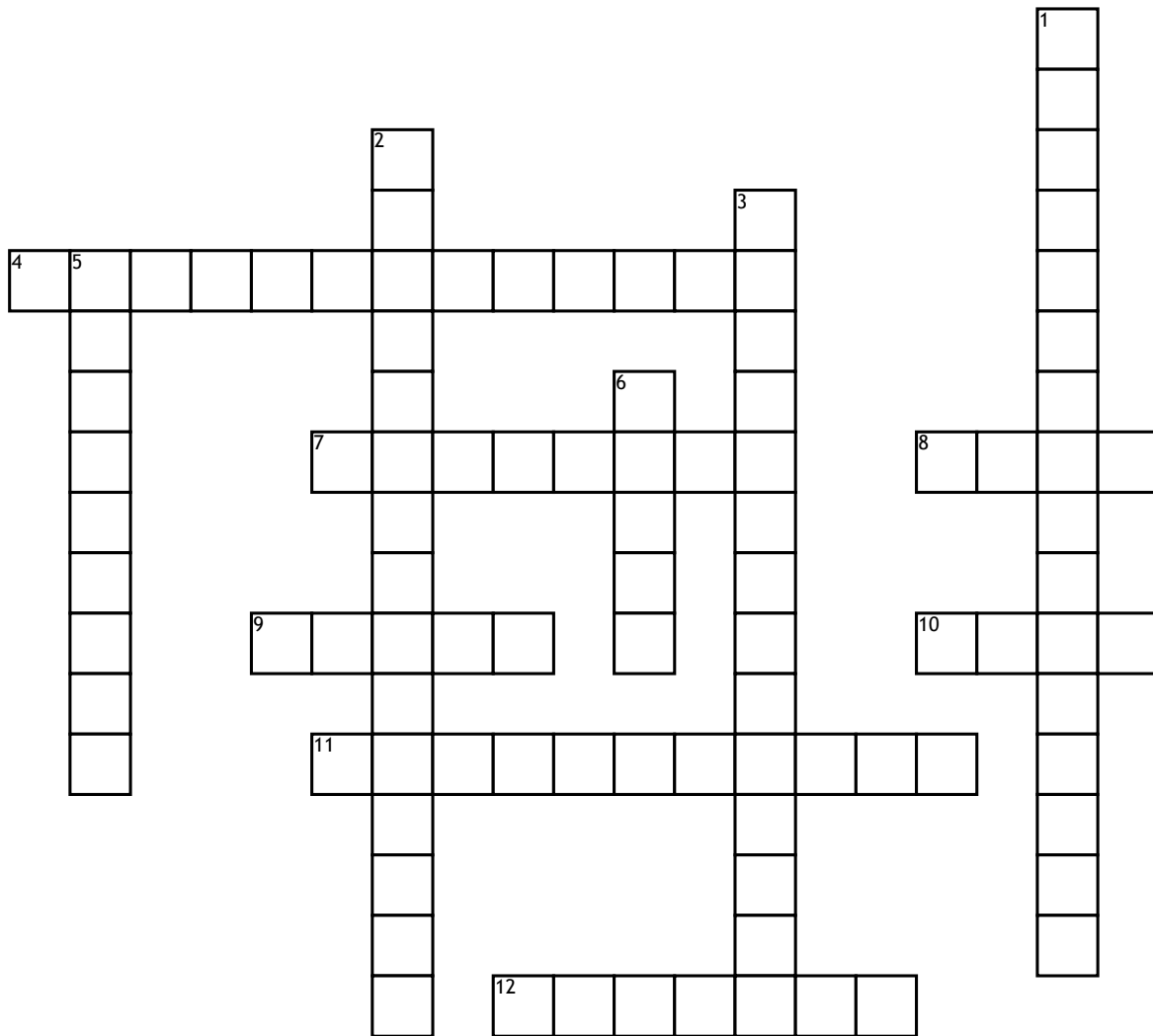


Roller Derby Pack Definition
