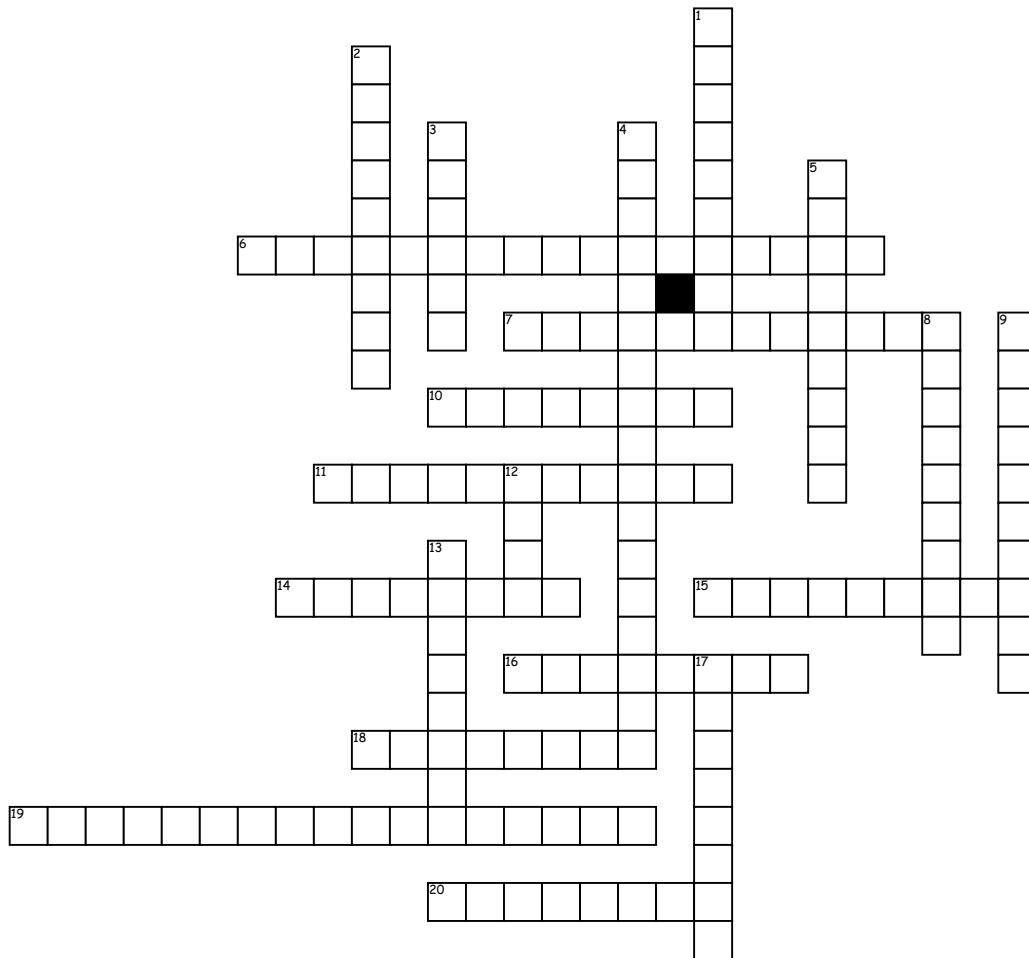


# Roman cross word puzzle
