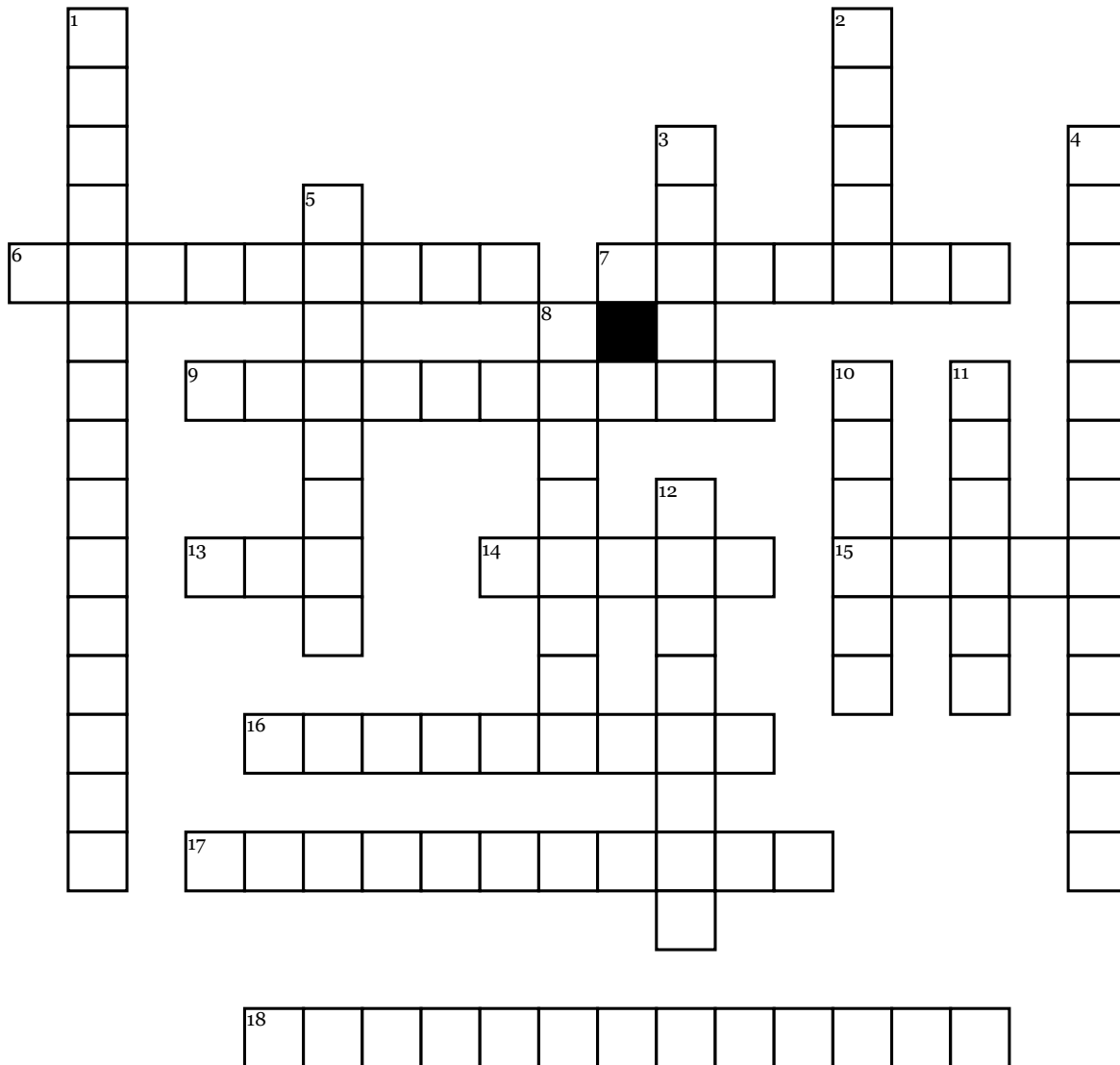

8. Romeo's cousin. Nephew to Lord and Lady Montague

10. Juliet's cousin. Romeo's enemy. Nephew to Lord and Lady Capulet. Killed by Romeo

11. Daughter of Lord and Lady Capulet--married to Romeo

12. Romeo's Best Friend--gets killed by Tybalt and is a close relative to the Prince
