
Roots/Stems

- **2.** horizontal, underground stems
- **4.** central axis of a plant with appendages that also contain the vascular system; responsible for supporting the plant
- **5.** Underground vegetative organ of a plant
- **6.** plant growth responses to environmental conditions
- 11. horizontal, above ground stems that produce buds and roots at the nodes

- **12.** region of stem between nodes
- **13.** underground, enlarged food storing stem covered by papery leaves
- **15.** vascular tissue that conducts water and inorganic materials
- **16.** vertical, underground stems with food storing leaves covered by papery leaves

1. growth of plant parts based on gravity

- **3.** orientation of a plant in relation to light
- **7.** regions of corp fields where the crop falls
- **8.** compressed above ground stems near soil surface with leaf and flower buds
- **9.** vascular tissue that conducts organic materials synthesized by the plant
- **10.** region of stem where leaves or branches arise
- **14.** enlarged underground stems that store large quantities of carbs
