
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Rule 2: Definitions

- **4.** A pass thrown with its initial direction parallel or towards the passer's end line.
- **6.** The action of 1 or more offensive players who move to a new set position before the ensuing snap.
- 13. A unit of the game.
- 15. A pass, fumble or kick.
- **17.** A loss of player possession other than by handing, passing, or punting the ball.
- **18.** When a player is illegally in the neutral zone.
- **19.** Gaining possession of a live ball after it strike the ground.

20. Legally obstructing an opponent without using any part of the body to initiate contact.

Down

- **1.** The catch of an opponent's fumble or pass.
- 2. The player who has thrown a legal forward pass.
- **3.** An attempt by a player to jump with 1 or both feet or knees over an opponent who is contact the ground.
- **5.** Refers to any contact with the ball; precedes a catch.
- **7.** From the forward point of the football 1 yard to B's scrimmage line.
- 8. A ball not in play

- 9. Any player who legally punts.
- **10.** A vertical plane separating the end zone from the field of play.
- 11. A ball in play
- **12.** An unsuccessful attempt to catch a ball, with the ball being touched in the attempt.
- **14.** The act of establish player possession of a live ball that is in flight.
- **16.** Intentionally slapping or redirecting the ball with the hand or arm.
