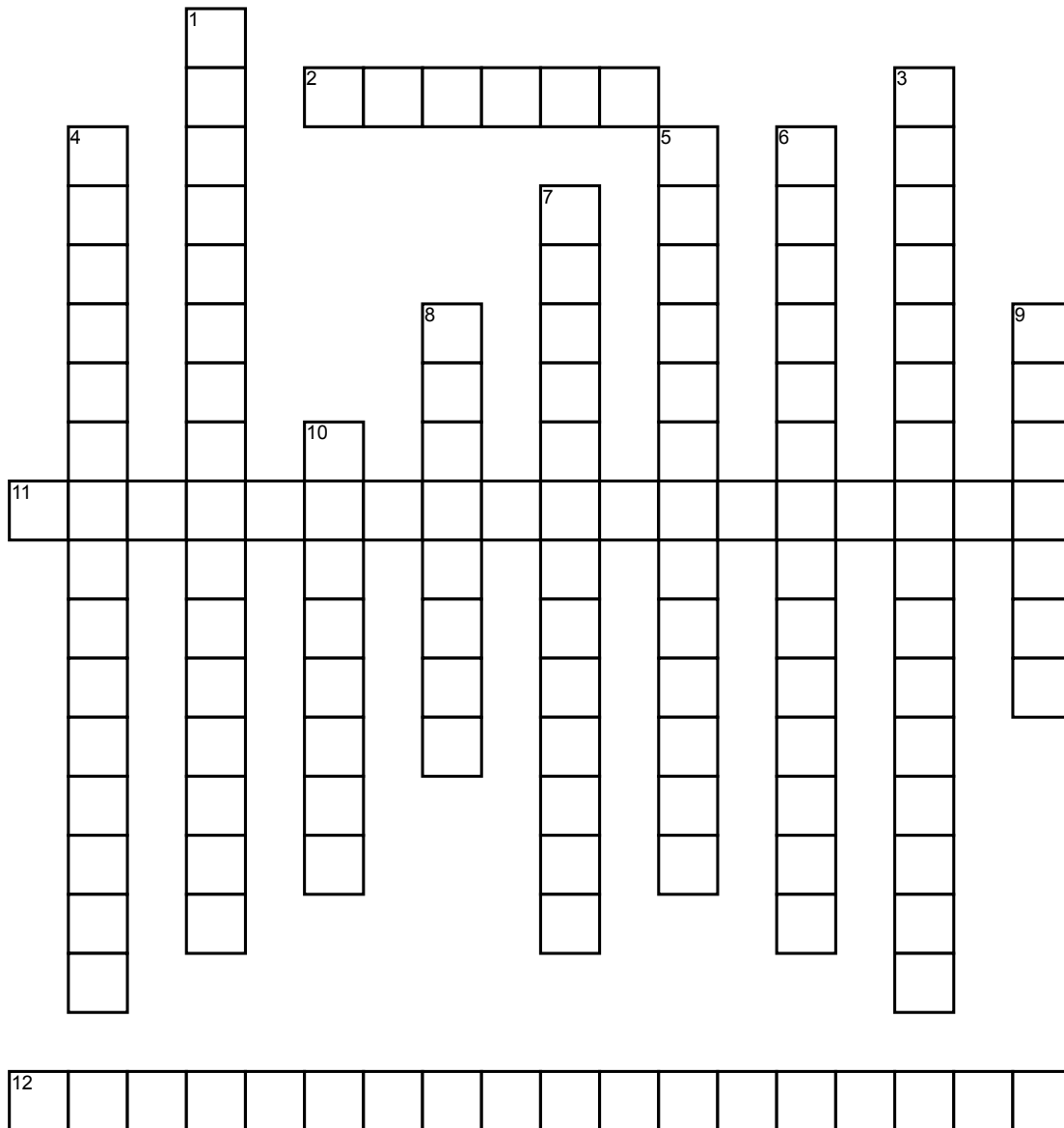


# SLAVERY DIVIDES THE NATION

**2.** to withdraw from membership in a group

**11.** Agreement, proposed in 1819 by Henry Clay, to keep the number of slaves and free states equal.

**12.** in the mid-1800s, a term referring to the idea that each territory could decide for itself whether or not to allow slavery

## **Down**

**1.** law passed in 1850 that required all citizens to aid in the capture of runaway slaves

**3.** Henry Clay introduced a series of resolutions on January 29, 1850 to seek compromise and avert a crisis between North and South

**4.** political party established in the United States in 1854 with the goal of keeping slavery out of the western territories

**5.** law passed in 1846 that banned slavery in any territories won by the United States from Mexico

**6.** an 1852 novel by Harriet Beecher Stowe written to show the evils of slavery and the injustice of the fugitive slave act

**7.** an anti slavery party founded in 1848 to keep slavery out of the western territories

**8.** war between people of the same country

**9.** place where guns are stored
