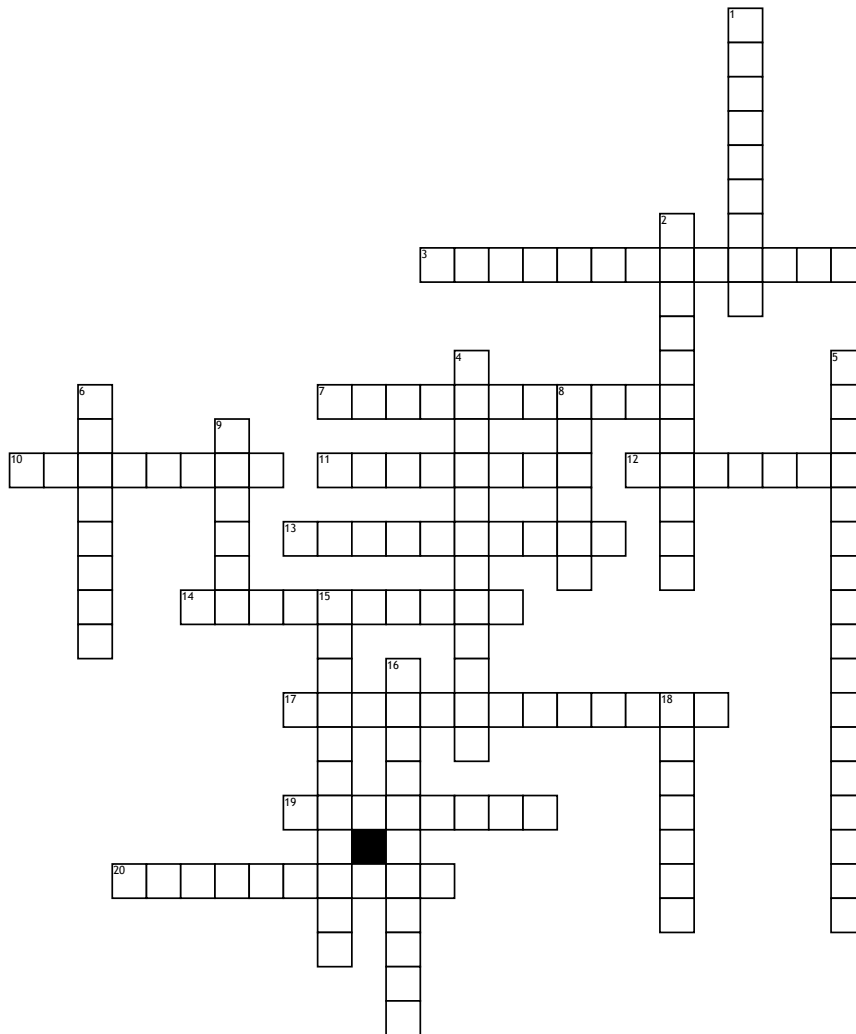

1. temporary or permanent loss of voluntary movement
 2. paralysis of one side of the body

6. an epileptic seizure chracterized by violent muscle contractions and loss of consciousness
 8. an involuntary repetitive trembling of the body or limbs
 9. exaggerated fear of a specific object or situation that causes anxiety and panic
 15. sensation of numbness, prickling or tingling
 16. congenital hernia in which the meninges protrude through an opening of the skull or spinal cord
 18. a temporary loss of consciousness due to inadequate blood flow to the brain
