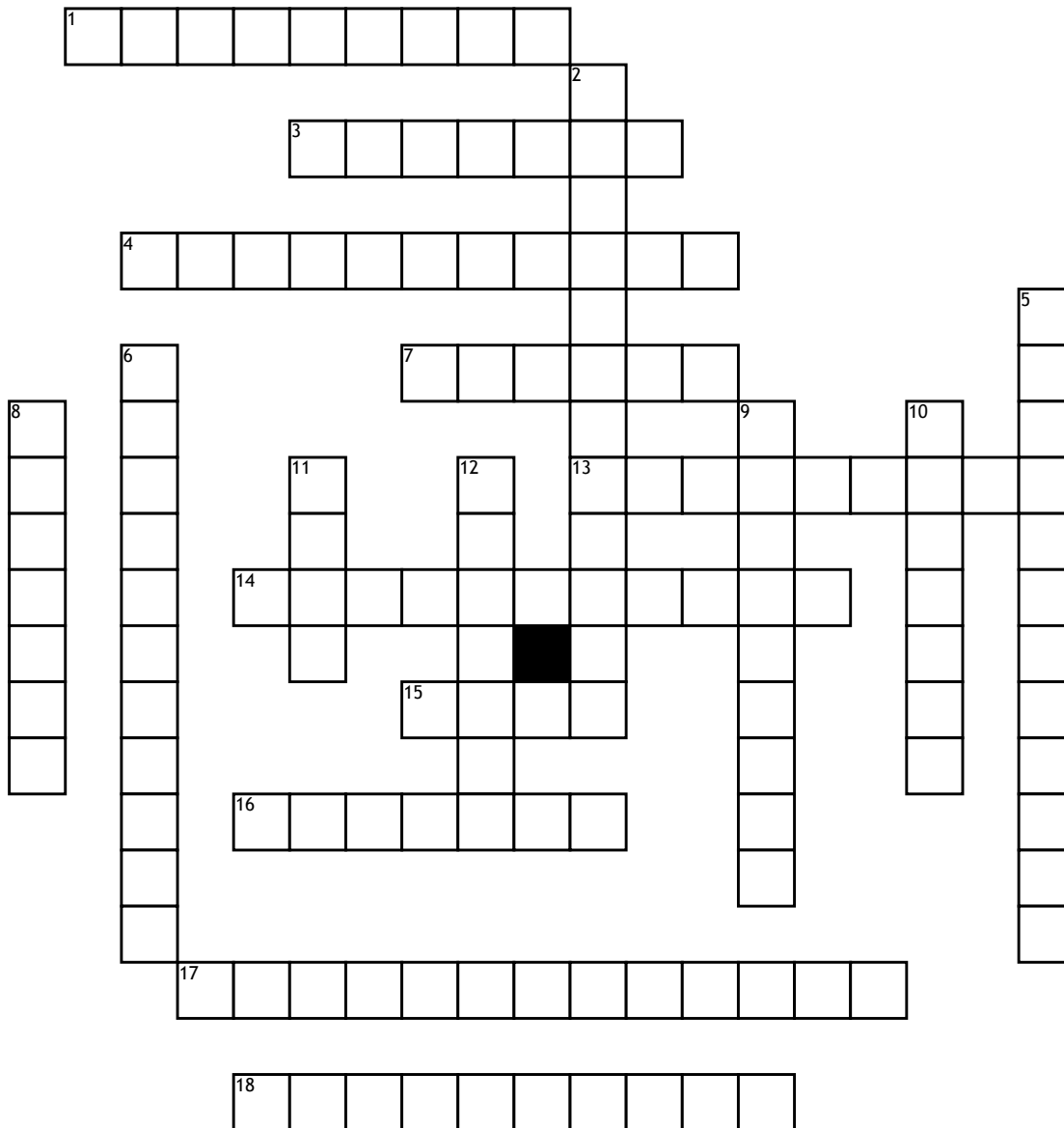

 3. A, AN, THE
 4. A SHORTENED FORM OF A WORD OR GROUP OF WORDS, WITH THE MISSING LETTERS USUALLY MARKED BY AN APOSTROPHE
 7. MODIFY A VERB. INDICATES MANNER, TIME, PLACE, CAUSE, OR DEGREE AND ANSWERS QUESTIONS SUCH AS "HOW, WHEN, WHERE, HOW MUCH"
 13. IDENTITY OR SIMILARITY IN SOUND BETWEEN INTERNAL VOWELS IN NEIGHBORING WORDS
 14. LINK NOUNS, PRONOUNS AND PHRASES TO OTHER WORDS IN SENTENCE
 15. PERSON, ANIMAL, PLACE, THING AND ABSTRACT IDEA

16. A WORD HAVING THE SAME OR NEARLY THE SAME MEANING AS ANOTHER WORD OR OTHER WORDS
 17. WORD COMPOSED OF TWO OR MORE WORDS

18. BROADLY, THE REPETITION OF CONSONANT SOUNDS

2. THE REPETITION OF AN INITIAL CONSONANT SOUND
 5. WORD ADDED TO A SENTENCE TO CONVEY EMOTION. IT IS NOT GRAMMATICALLY RELATED TO ANY OTHER PART OF THE SENTENCE
 6. A WORD WHICH LINKS WORDS, PHRASES OR CLAUSES
 8. WORD FORMED FROM THE INITIAL LETTERS OF A NAME, SUCH AS NASA/ NBA

9. ONE OF TWO OR MORE WORDS PRONOUNCED ALIKE BUT DIFFERENT IN MEANING

10. A WORD HAVING A MEANING OPPOSITE TO THAT OF ANOTHER WORD
 11. ASSERTS SOMETHING ABOUT THE SUBJECT OF THE SENTENCE AND EXPRESS ACTIONS, EVENTS, OR STATES OF BEING
 12. REPLACES ANOTHER NOUN OR PRONOUN
