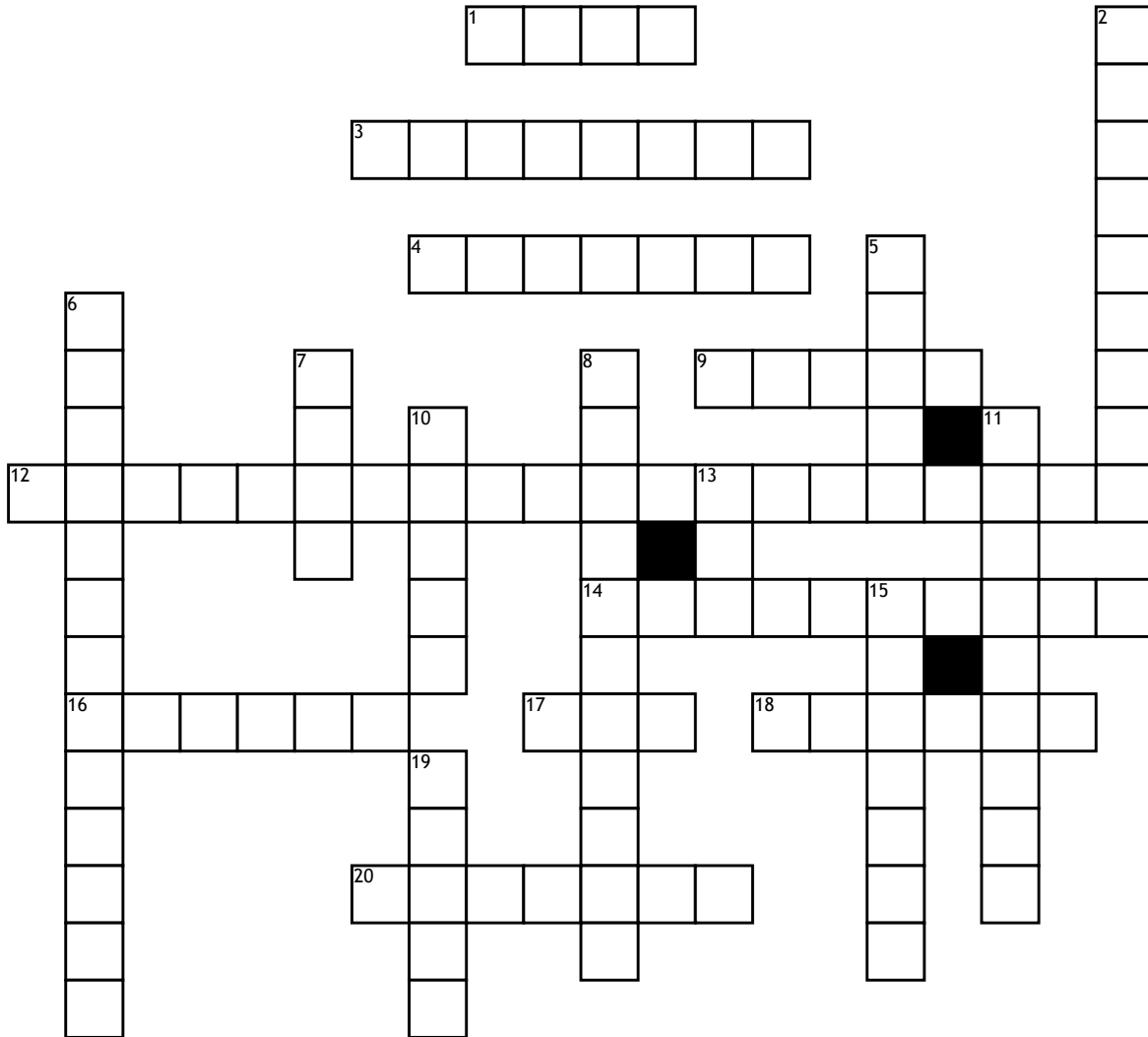


Safety and Emergencies Crossword
