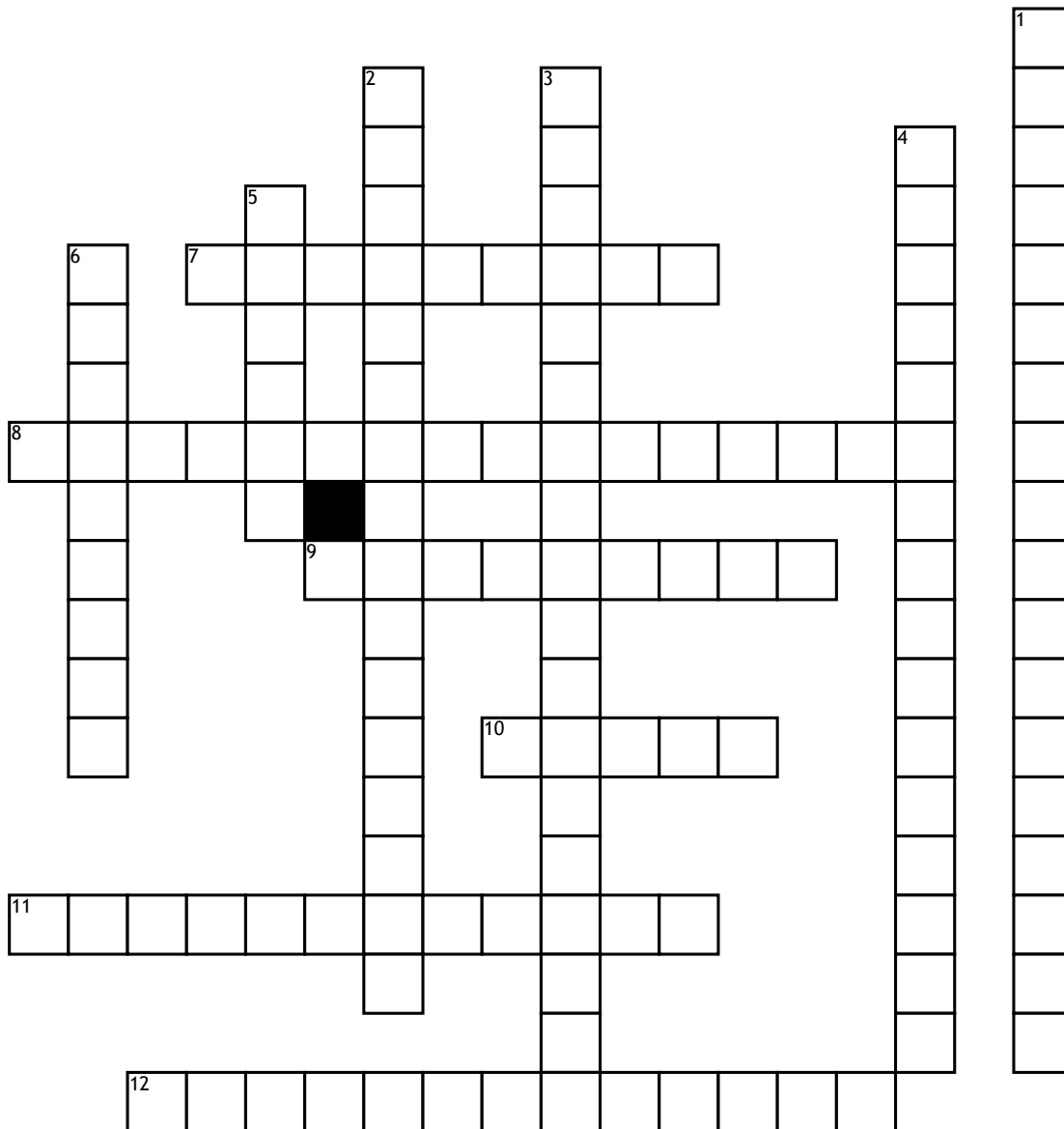


Science Cross Word Puzzle
