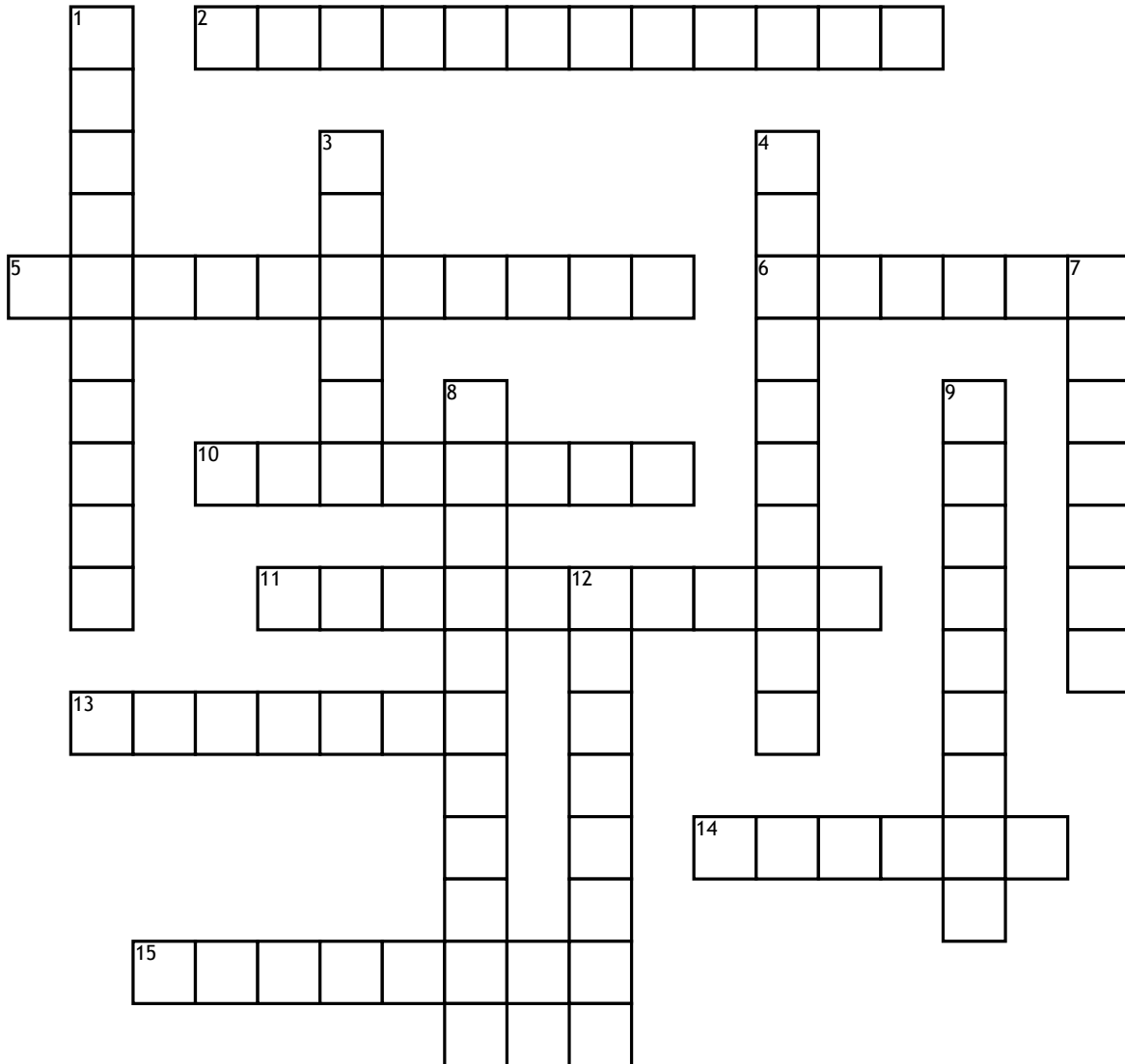


Science Menu Crossword Puzzle
