Secondary Causes of Headaches

1. Nuchal rigidity with a positive Brudzinski and Kernig sign
 2. "The worst headache of my life."
 3. Papilledema; Persistent headache
 4. Onset of severe headache after 50 years of age
 5. Fever; Stiff neck; Photophobia
 6. Provoked by valsalva maneuver
 7. Occurs in young obese females
 8. Presence of focal neurologic deficits
 9. Unilateral headache with ocular symptoms, including loss of vision
 10. Secondary to chronic analgesic use
