- 2. "The worst headache of my life."
- 3. Papilledema; Persistent headache
- 4. Onset of severe headache after 50 years of age

- 6. Provoked by valsalva maneuver
- 7. Occurs in young obese females
- 8. Presence of focal neurologic deficits
- 9. Unilateral headache with ocular symptoms, including loss of vision
- 10. Secondary to chronic analgesic use
