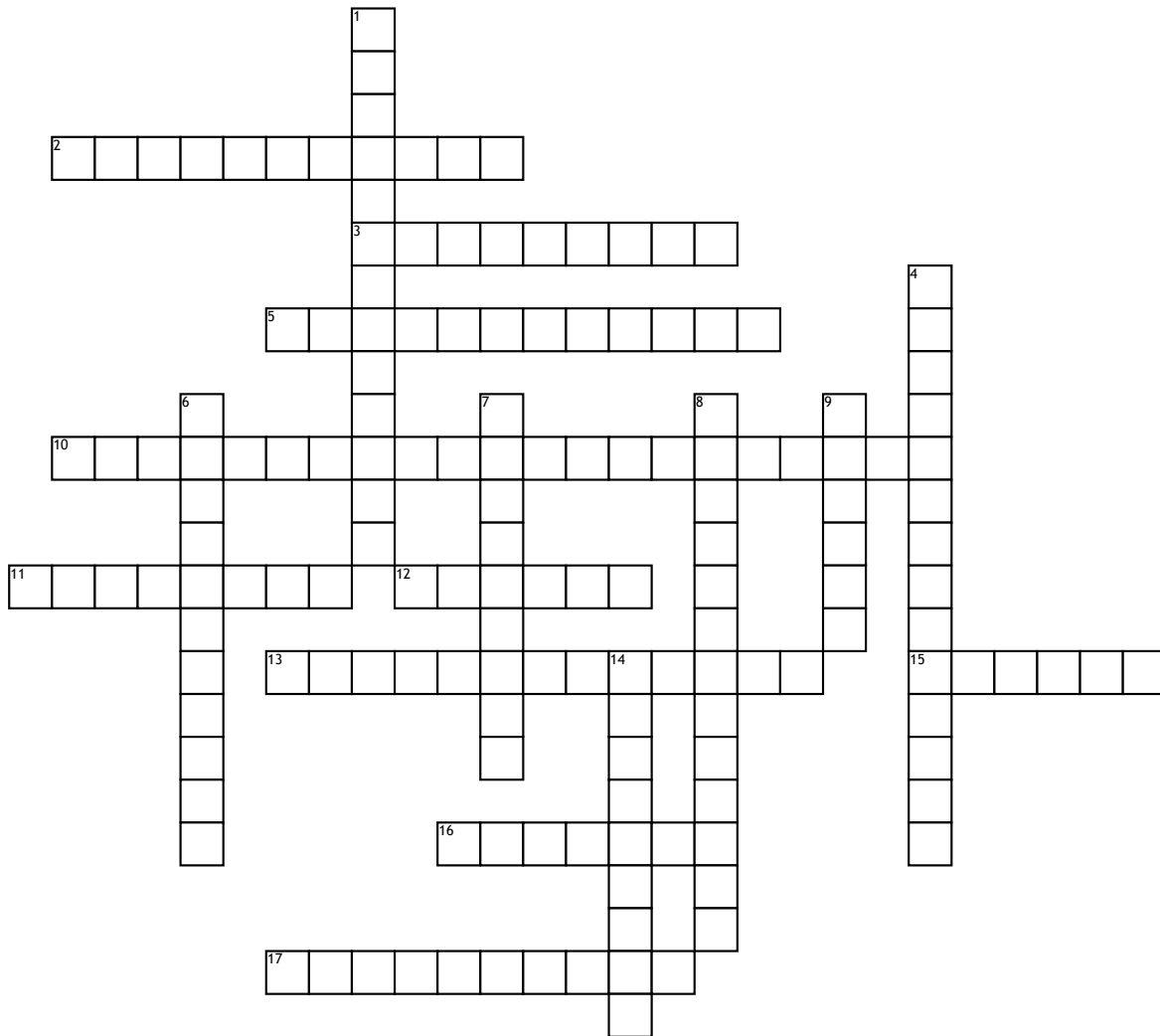


# Sensory Medical Terminology
