

- **6.** Used to measure short lengths, such as hem and seam widths. Is 6 inces long and has plastic sliding marker.
- **7.** Used to get the wrnkles out of fabric.
- **8.** Used to hold two layers of fabric together.
- **10.** A long metal rod with a hook that is used to bias tubing right side out.
- 11. A flexible tape that is 60 inches long, used for body measurements

13. Used with tracing paper to transfer lines on fabric. Most common one has a saw-tooth blade.

- 1. Tool used to help protect fingers when sewing by hand.
- **2.** Small squares used for marking fabric.
- **3.** A firm, round cushion used to press curved areas of a garment.
- **4.** Used for removing stitches and has a small blade on the end.

- **5.** Used for cutting fabric and has a bent handle,. One handle is larger than the other.
- **9.** Shears that have a zig zag design to help prevent raveling.
