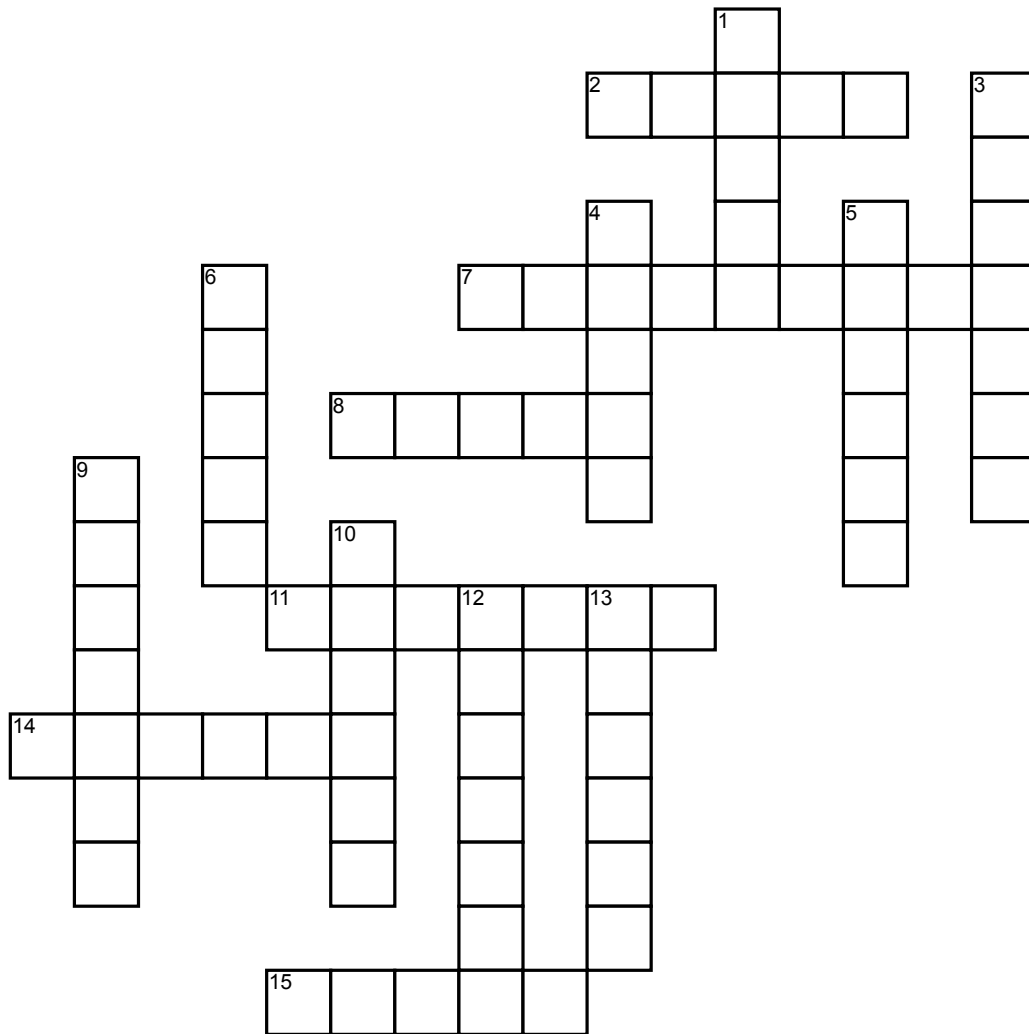


Shakespearean Words

 5. This word means 'with' and 'with' is actually in the word

6. This word means to 'love' or to mention 'love' (Words surrounded in apostrophes show what the word that needs to be found means)
