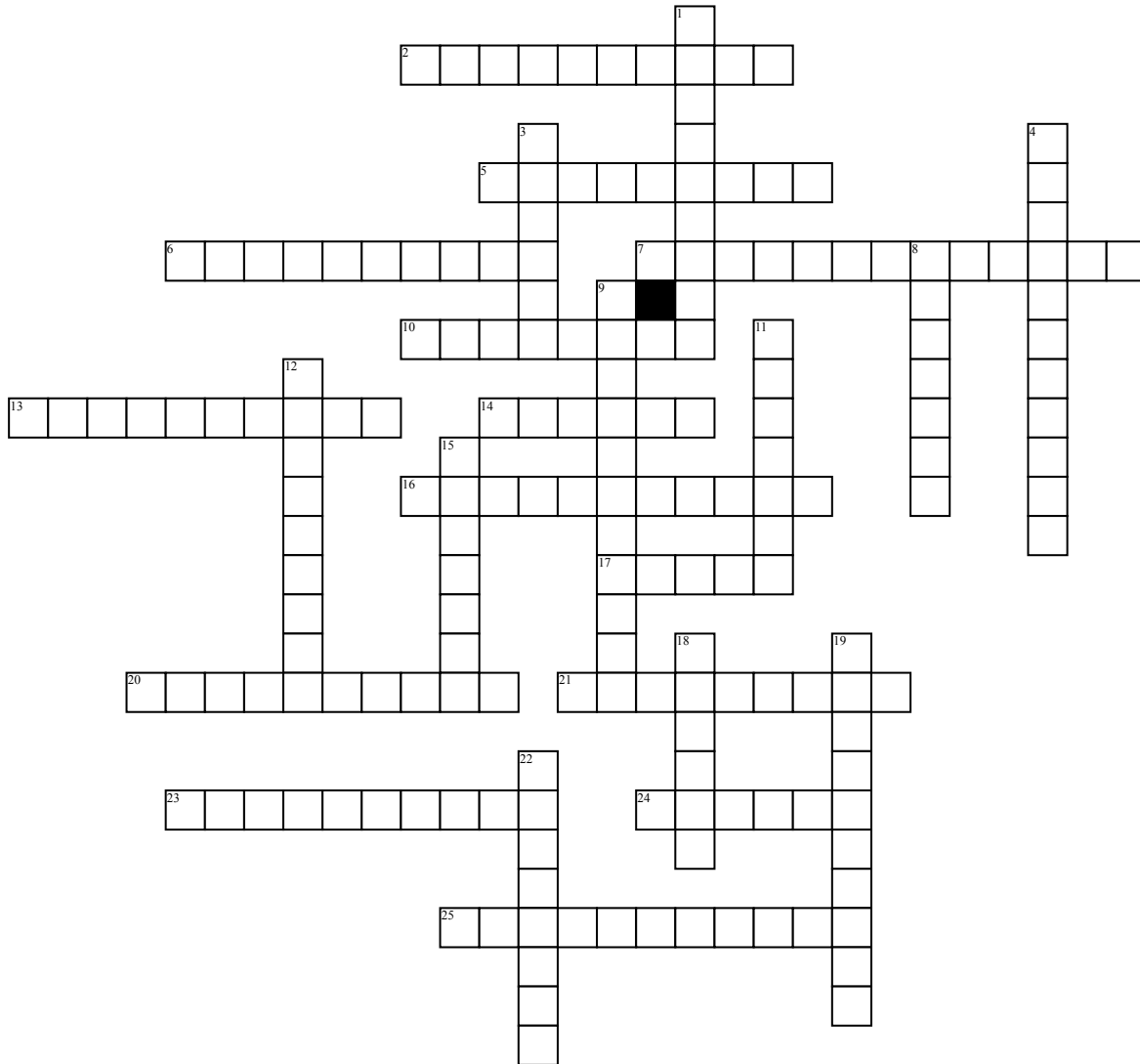


Sherlock Crossword Puzzle
