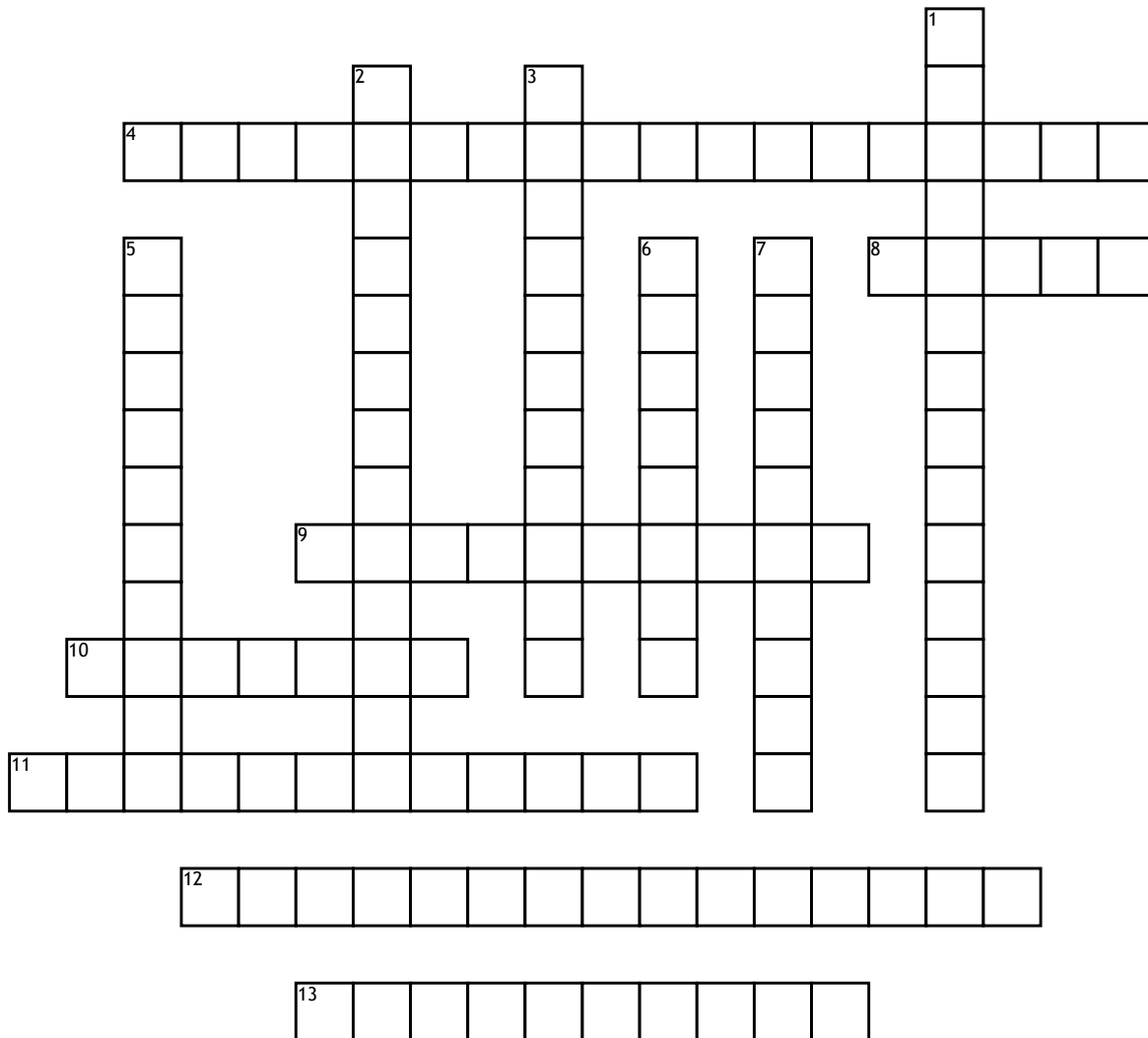

4. Extends posteriorly from below first lower molar to angle of mandible

8. Small process in center of inferior of soft palate

9. Formed by the horizontal plates of the maxillae and palatine bones

10. The largest Salivary gland, lies anterior to external ear, inferior to mandibular ramus and posterior to mastoid process

11. Major duct supplying saliva from parotid gland

12. The smallest pair of salivary glands, located in the floor of mouth beneath sublingual fold

13. First part of digestive cavity
