
## Skeletal System 4



## Across

- 3. (5) sturdiest vertebrae
- **4.** canal through which the spinal cord passes
- **7.** formed by the fusion of 5 vertebraes
- **13.** only bone that does not articulate directly with any other bone
- 15. lower jaw
- 16. (7) from the neck region to spine
- **17.** single projection arising from the posterior aspect
- 19. forms most of the nasal spectum
- **20.** fibrous membrane connecting the cranial bones
- 21. forms the bridge of the bones

- **23.** thoracic & sacral regions are present when we are born
- **24.** larger than the cervical vertebrae
- 25. "dens"; acts as a pivot point

## Down

- **1.** appears when baby walks and lifts their head
- 2. spine
- **5.** separates the bones of the spine
- **6.** separates vertebraes by pads of flexible cartilage
- 8. acts as a pivot for the rotation of the atlas
- 9. serves as passage way for tears

- **10.** two lateral projections from the vertebral arch
- 11. cheek bones
- **12.** thin, curved bones projecting from the lateral walls of the nasal cavity
- **14.** formed from the joining of all posterior extension
- **18.** disclike, weight bearing part of the vertebrae
- **22.** receives the occipital condyles of the skull this joint allows you to nod
