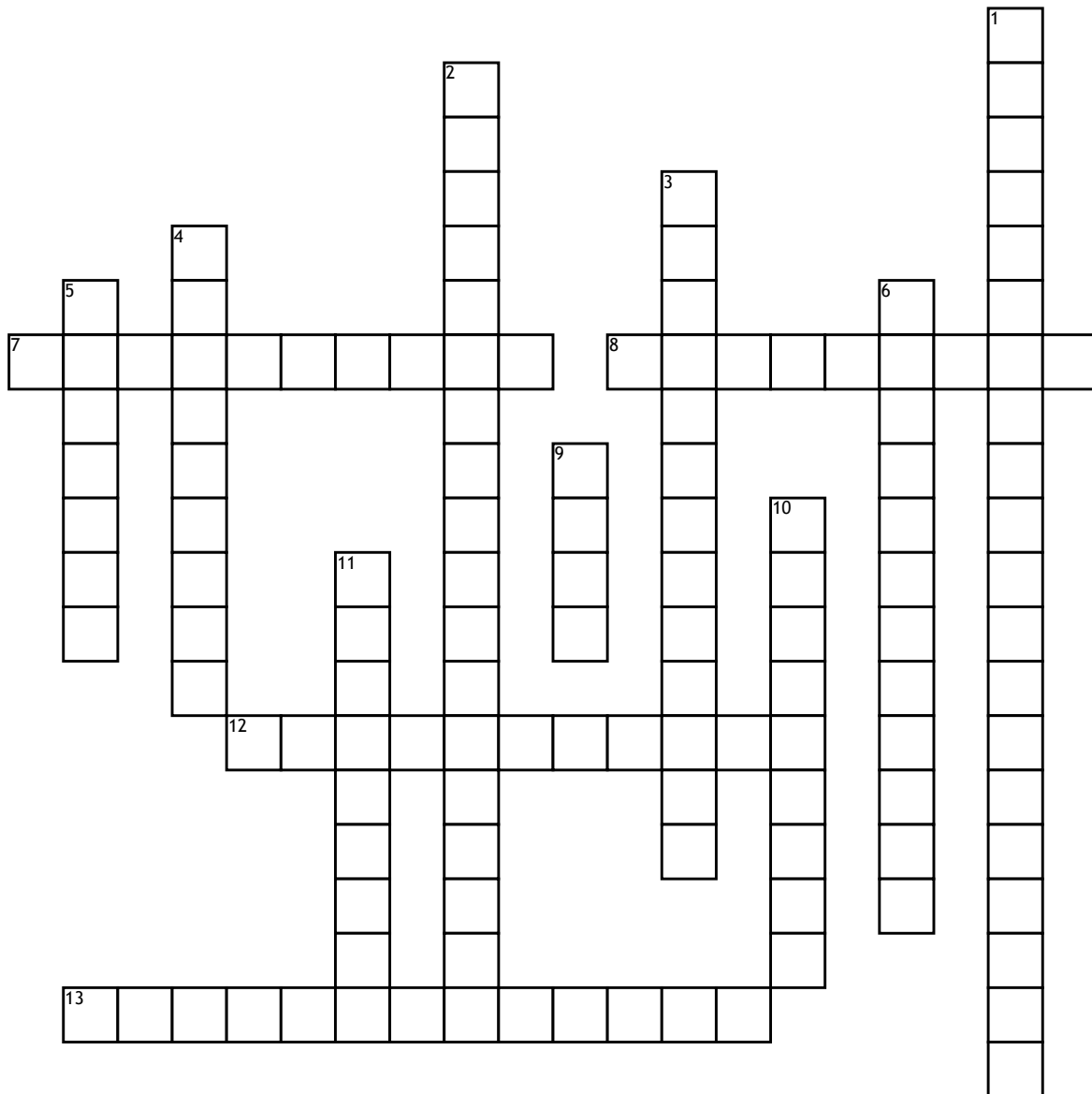

# Skeletal System



**Across**

- 7. The tough connective tissue that covers the outside of the bone.
- 8. The shaft and main portion of the bone.
- 12. The range of movement is freely movable for this joint.
- 13. Includes the skull, vertebral column, ribs, sternum

**Down**

- 1. Includes the arms, legs and those attached to them, i.e shoulder, pelvic girdle.

- 2. Is responsible for reducing friction and absorbing shocks at freely movable joints.
- 3. The range of movement is slightly moveable for the joint.
- 4. The proximal and distal ends of the bone.
- 5. Composed of dense fibrous connective tissue that attaches muscle to bone.
- 6. The range of movement is fixed or unmoveable for the joint.

- 9. A highly vascular connective tissue with osteogenic cells that are separated by bone matrix
- 10. A single layer of bone-producing cells line the inner surfaces of the cavities within the bone.
- 11. A flexible connective tissue connecting two bones or holds joints together.
