
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## Skeletal System



## Across

- **3.** An irregular meshing of small, bony plates that makes up spongy bone; it's spaces are filled with Red Marrow
- **8.** The part of the skeleton that consists of the head, veryebral column, ribs, and sternum
- **9.** The lighter-weight portion of a bone, which is made up of trabecula
- **10.** Round bones that often are embedded in tendons and joint capsules. The largest of these is the patella.
- **11.** Another word for joint, the structure created when bones connect to each other

## Down

- 1. The smooth, hard portion of bone that surrounds spongy bone and helps provide the firm framework of the body
- **2.** A tough, flexible connective tissue that is softer than bone
- **4.** A thin membrane of connective tissue that lines the marrow cavity of a bone
- **5.** The thin membrane of connective tissue that covers bones except at articulations
- **6.** The foramen that the spinal cord goes through
- **7.** The part of the skeleton composed of the limbs and their attachments
