

- **3.** Canal perpendicular to the central canal
- **5.** Cavity of the shaft
- **8.** Covers the external surface of the epiphyses
- **10.** After growth is complete cartilage hardens
- **12.** functional unit of compact bone
- **13.** Outside covering of the diaphysis. Fibrous connective tissue membrane

- **14.** dense, smooth, solid-gives bones strength
- **18.** Bone forming cells
- **19.** Opening in the center of an osteon
- **20.** mature bone cells, enclosed in tiny chambers
- 1. No True Osteons
- **4.** Composed of compact bone
- **6.** increase bone length as the cells ossify/harden
- **7.** are aligned concentrically around a vascular canal

- **9.** one of the minute cavities in bone or cartilage occupied by the osteocytes.
- 11. In the medullary cavities of long bones, stores fat
- **15.** Bone cells that dissolve/breaks down bone matrix
