
Skeletal System Vocab

- **3.** smooth, white tissue that covers ends of bones
- **5.** cerebrospinal fluid-filled space that runs longitudinally through the length of entire spinal cord
- 7. replaces epiphyseal plate once growth stops
- 12. midsection of long bone
- **14.** central canal containing blood capillaries and concentric osseous lamellae around it occurring in compact bone
- **16.** contain red and white blood cells and platelets
- **18.** cavity/ depression in bone

- **19.** provides energy and nourishing elements for osteons
- **20.** growth plate closest to joint **Down**
- 1. made of spongy bone, and covered in articular cartilage
- 2. large multinucleate bone cell that absorbs bone tissue during growth
- **4.** dense layer of vascular connective tissue around bones
- **6.** central cavity of bone shafts where red/yellow bone marrow is stored
- **8.** contains mostly fat cells and develops some white blood cells

- **9.** plate of hyaline cartilage found in children/ adolescence. located in metaphysis
- **10.** cell that secretes the matrix for bone formation
- **11.** bone cell, when osteoblast becomes embedded in matrix
- **13.** thin layer, membrane, platelike tissue
- **15.** (cancellous bone), porous and highly vascularized and contains red bone marrow
- 17. (cortical bone), dense bone in which the bony matrix is filled with organic ground substance and inorganic salts
