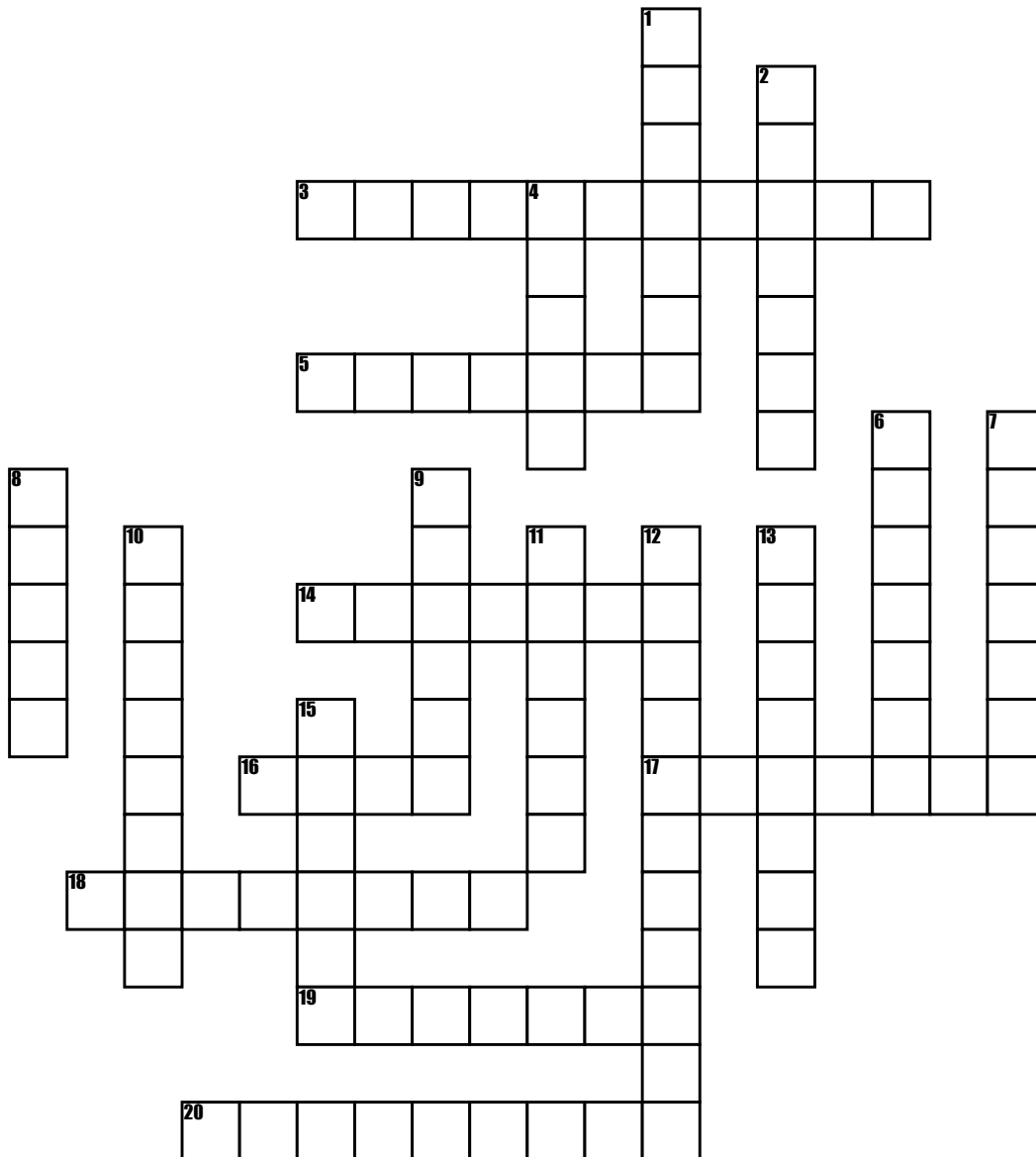


# Skeletal System

**3.** Any of the bones of the foot

**5.** the skull, especially the part enclosing the brain.

**14.** the bony frame formed by the ribs around the chest.

**16.** the thinner and longer of the two bones in the human forearm, on the side opposite to the thumb.

**17.** A group of bones in your wrist

**18.** technical term for collarbone.

**19.** the jaw or jawbone, specifically the upper jaw in most vertebrates. In humans it also forms part of the nose and eye socket.

**20.** A group of bones at the fingers

## **Down**

**1.** The Breastbone

**2.** technical term for shoulder blade.

**4.** the inner and typically larger of the two bones between the knee and the ankle

**6.** the kneecap

**7.** A group of bones at the ankle

**8.** The bone of the thigh or upper hind limb, articulating at the hip and the knee.

**9.** The outer and usually smaller of the two bones between the knee and the ankle in humans (or The equivalent joints in other terrestrial vertebrates), parallel with the tibia.

**10.** the jaw or a jawbone, especially the lower jawbone in mammals and fishes.

**11.** the thicker and shorter of the two bones in the human forearm.

**12.** A group of bones in the hand

**13.** A long bone in the arm or forelimb that runs from the shoulder to the elbow.

**15.** the large broad bone forming the upper part of each half of the pelvis.
