

19. the jaw or jawbone, specifically the upper jaw in most vertebrates. In humans it also forms part of the nose and eye socket.

8. The bone of the thigh or upper hind limb, articulating at the hip and the knee.

9. The outer and usually smaller of the two bones between the knee and the ankle in humans (or The equivalent joints in other terrestrial vertebrates), parallel with the tibia.

10. the jaw or a jawbone, especially the lower jawbone in mammals and fishes.

11. the thicker and shorter of the two bones in the human forearm.

12. A group of bones in the hand

13. A long bone in the arm or forelimb that runs from the shoulder to the elbow.

15. the large broad bone forming the upper part of each half of the pelvis.
