
Skeletal System

- **15.** a group of small bones between the main part of the hind limb and the metatarsus in terrestrial vertebrates

- **16.** the jaw or a jawbone
- **17.** relating to the bones forming the human carpus (wrist)
- 18. technical term for shoulder blade.
- **19.** each of a series of slender curved bones articulated in pairs to the spine
- **20.** the bone of the thigh or upper hind limb, articulating at the hip and the knee.

- **2.** the area of the spinal column that comprises the low back
- 3. a bone of the finger or toe

- 4. the vertebrae of the neck
